<sup>2</sup> Gross rate of pay as defined in the [Employment Act](#) means the total amount of money including allowances to which an employee is entitled under his contract of service either for working for a period of time, that is, for one hour, one day, one week, one month or for such other period as may be stated or implied in his contract of service, or for each completed piece or task of work but does not include —

(a) additional payments by way of overtime payments;  
 (b) additional payments by way of bonus payments or annual wage supplements;  
 (c) any sum paid to the employee to reimburse him for special expenses incurred by him in the course of his employment;  
 (d) productivity incentive payments; and  
 (e) travelling, food or housing allowances.
