

SUMMARY OF PROPOSALS

EmancipAsia

i. Photography exhibition and film screenings

EmancipAsia has proposed using artistic visuals, through photography exhibition and film screenings, to tug at the heart strings of the audience. These mediums can create a long-lasting emotional impact to shape the audience's personal and social attitudes.

ii. National Sporthaton

They are also organising a National Sporthaton walk-or-jog event to raise funds for non-profit organisations that work on TIP issues. To join, participants will need to find a sponsor and explain to them the basic facts of TIP, increasing their awareness of TIP.

iii. Break the chain event

At the "Break the chain" event, participants will have to form a long chain and walk from one location to another. Once they have reached the destination, the chain will be broken signifying the end of modern day slavery.

iv. Data collection

EmancipAsia will collect and document data obtained from victims of sex trafficking to aid the understanding of the issue so as to formulate appropriate awareness-raising strategies and TIP preventive measures.

UN Women and HOME

UN Women and HOME will be conducting talks for industry associations, chambers of commerce and business owners, especially employers of migrant workers, to educate them about how they can help prevent the issue of TIP as part of their corporate social responsibility.

They will also organise a multi-sectoral TIP conference involving participants from multiple sectors such as non-profit organisations, Government agencies, businesses, academia, potential victims and youth networks to share their views and insights on TIP-related topics.

SMU and NUS

SMU and NUS will conduct two public seminars, one each on labour and sex trafficking.
