Protect yourself from heat stroke!




You may get heat stroke when working under the hot sun for long hours.


Here are some tips on preventing heat stroke.



Drink lots of water. At least one glass (250ml) every 15-20 minutes and whenever needed to quench thirst.



Work with a partner and look out for any early signs of heat stroke, such as headache, nausea and fainting.



Wear loose-fitting and light coloured clothes when outdoors and work under the shade whenever possible

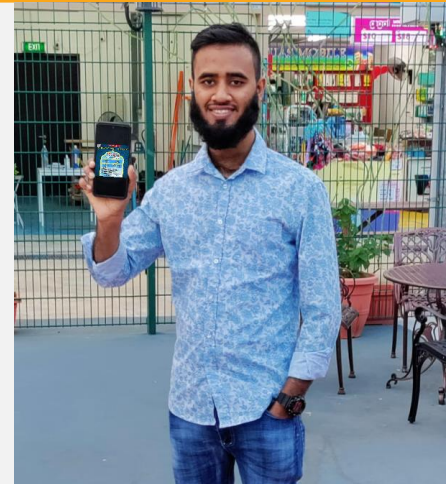
If you are unwell, inform your supervisor immediately and see a doctor.

This is Sohal Mazi, our migrant worker friend from Bangladesh. Despite working night shifts most days, Sohal set aside time to learn graphic design from 24asia for 6 months. Since then, graphic design has become his interest, and he has been creating posters in his free time.
