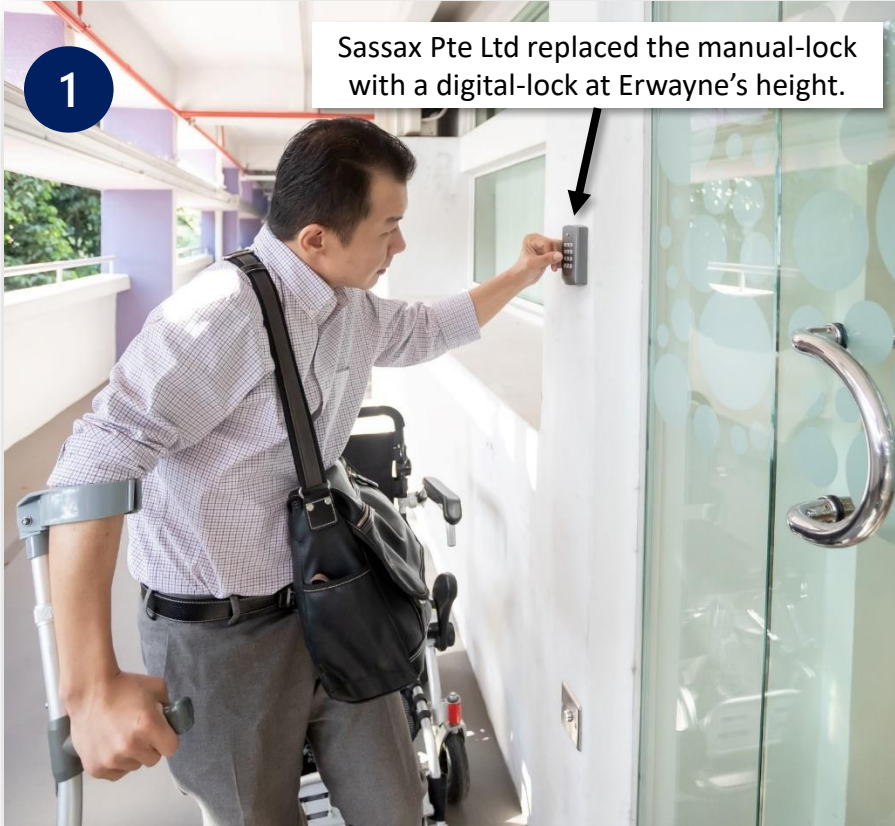

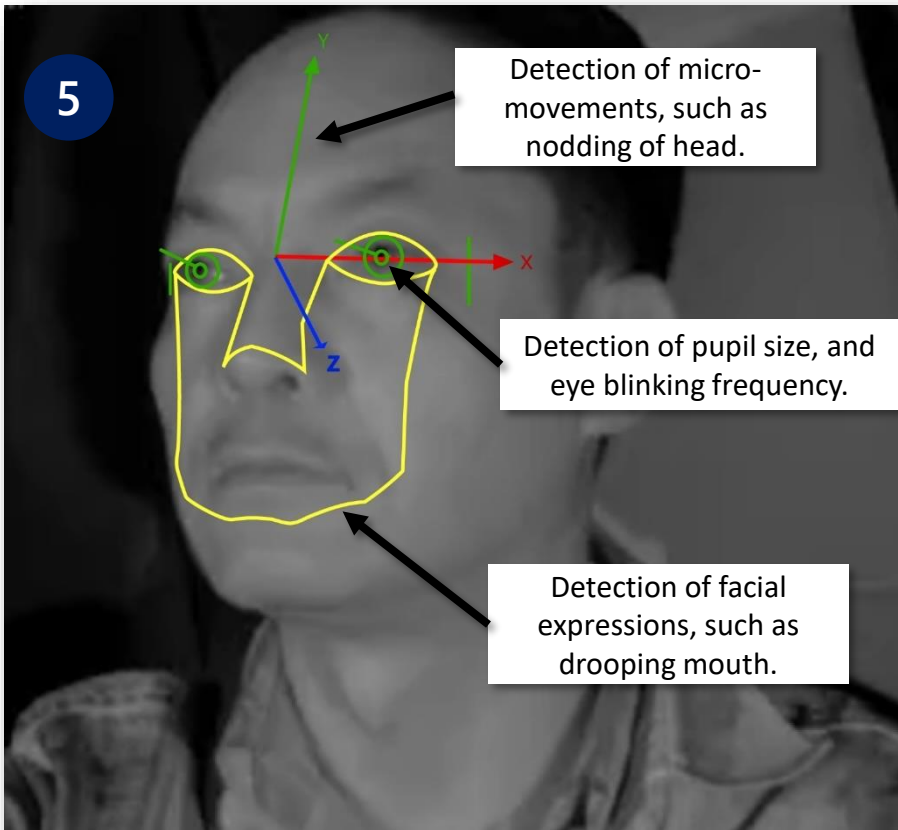
Top management commitment to WSH
