

### Kickbacks can happen to migrant workers in various ways

- Salary deductions for employment-related costs that should be paid by the employer (e.g., for work pass renewal or medical insurance)
- Collection of money by the employer as a condition for the worker's continued employment





## The case of Shan Jianxin who collected kickbacks for work pass renewal

A group of migrant workers filed a complaint to MOM. They were required to pay renewal fees of \$3,000 to \$5,000 for continued employment

The employer was imprisoned for 30 weeks for kickbacks and other employment offences





# What migrant workers should do if they are paying kickbacks



#### Step 1

Take note of the payment details (e.g. when, how much, who it was paid to)

If possible, collect documents, screenshots of text messages, photos or videos



#### Step 2

#### Report to MOM:

- Approach any ACE officer at the dormitory

- Walk in to MOM Services Centre at 1500 Bendemeer Road, Singapore 339946
