Changing of Employers*

From 1 July 2022,

- If your work permit is expiring soon, you may:
 - Discuss with your current employer to renew your work permit, or
 - Transfer to a new employer between **40 to 21 days before your Work Permit expires**. Your current employer's consent is **not needed**.
- For more information, you may contact the Ministry of Manpower at 6438 5122, or contact the Forward Assurance and Support Team (FAST) officers

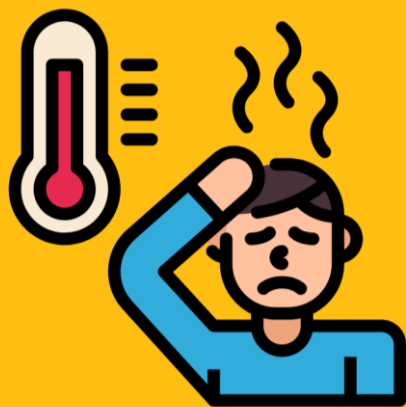

What you need to know about Monkeypox



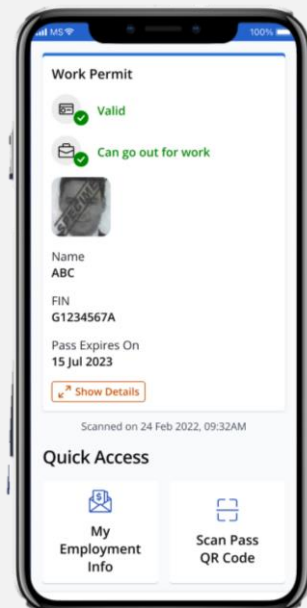
As we continue to see cases of monkeypox in the community, please seek immediate medical attention if you develop any of the symptoms below:

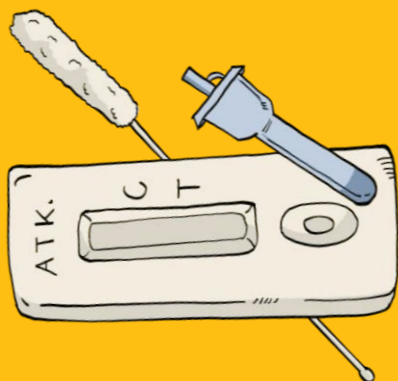


Enhancement of SGWorkPass mobile application

Distribution of Antigen Rapid Test Kits

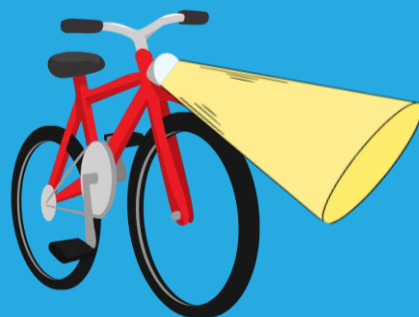
- If you are living in a dormitory, you will be **given 5 Antigen Rapid Test (ART) kits**

To commemorate Hari Raya Haji, congregational prayers were arranged for our Muslim migrant workers. Over at Kranji Recreation Centre, the Alliance of Guest Workers Outreach (AGWO) organised a carnival for migrant workers.

Senior Minister of State, Mr Zaqy Mohamad also visited An-Nur Mosque on 23 July to distribute korban meat and goodie bag items to migrant workers.
