Verifying higher education certificates from China

Employment agencies (EAs) can now verify the authenticity of educational certificates obtained from PRC foreign workers and China suppliers, via the China Higher-education Student Information (CHSI) website at, http://job.chsi.com.cn/.

You are required to register with the CHSI website to access the services. As the website and the relevant forms are in Chinese, it is recommended that you assign a personnel who is proficient in the language to work through the steps. Alternatively, you can engage the assistance of EAs in the PRC, to follow through with the registration process. If you require further clarification, please contact the CHSI
