Background

The Tripartite Committee on Employability of Older Workers was first set up in 2005 to recommend measures to enhance the employability of older workers. It aims to shape the perceptions and mindsets of employers and the public positively towards the employment of older workers.

The Committee is chaired by Mr Sam Tan, Minister of State for Manpower, and comprises representatives from employer organisations, unions and the government. The Committee provides strategic direction to advance tripartite efforts in supporting the employment, employability and productivity of older workers. The five strategic thrusts for the Committee are (a) improving workplace practices and support, (b) raising productivity and skills of older workers, (c) shaping positive perceptions of older workers, (d) enhancing employment facilitation and (e) improving retirement planning.
