

Guide on how to pay foreign worker levy using PayNow QR in Check & Pay Levy

Important Note:

Please scan the QR code to make payment and do not make direct transfer to the UEN (i.e., T08GA0019CCPL) you see in the screenshot. We are unable to update the payment promptly if you make direct transfer to the UEN. This will result in late payment penalty charges and possibly revocation of the work passes for levy default.

For DBS/POSB Bank customers

Step 1. Log in to Check & Pay Levy at www.mom.gov.sg/checkpaylevy. Select “Generate PayNow QR code”.





Scan QR Code


Line up with the frame to scan PayLah!, NETS, SGQR, PayNow QR codes.
