

MOM to Consolidate Services at New Bendemeer Centre

The Ministry of Manpower (MOM) will consolidate its operations at its new Bendemeer Centre by the first half of 2012. This will enable MOM to provide seamless and integrated one-stop services to the public.

- 2 The project will see the re-location of:
 - Work injury, employment claims, and work pass appeals currently at Havelock Road;
 - Occupational safety & health and foreign manpower investigations currently at Kim Seng Road; and
 - Work pass services currently at Tanjong Pagar Road.

The Workplace Safety & Health Council (WSHC), currently at Maxwell Road, will also be re-located to the Bendemeer Centre.

- The new centre, to be built at the cost of \$73 million at 1500 Bendemeer Road, is centrally located and well-served by bus services and within walking distance of the Potong Pasir MRT station.
