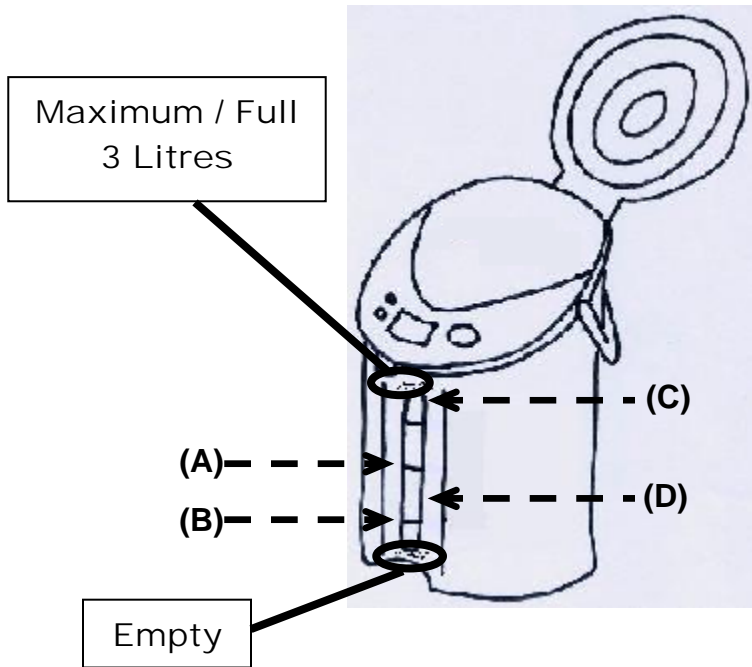

**Singapore Laws & You**

Singapore laws apply to Singapore citizens, permanent residents and foreigners. When you work here, you must obey Singapore's laws or face the penalties for breaking the law.

If you face personal safety or security problems, you are advised to call the Police at **999** or Embassy or High Commission.



Here are the penalties for breaking some of the laws:

Offence	Penalty
Public drunkenness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Imprisonment of up to 1 month or fine of up to S\$1,000.</li></ul>
Making a false report	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Imprisonment of up to 6 months or fine of up to S\$1,000 or both.</li></ul>
Housebreaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Imprisonment of up to 2 years or fine, or both.</li><li>Imprisonment of up to 3 years or fine, or both if housebreaking is committed at night.</li></ul>
Theft (stealing or shoplifting)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Imprisonment of between 3 and 7 years or fine, or both.</li></ul>
Overstaying	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Imprisonment of up to 6 months or fine of up to S\$4,000, or both.</li><li>At least 3 strokes of the cane and imprisonment of up to 6 months (if the period of overstaying exceeds 90 days.)</li></ul>

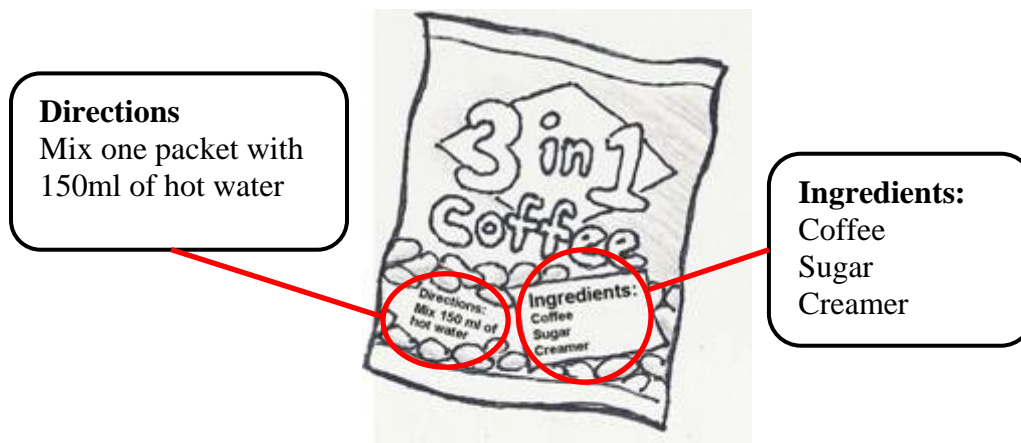
