EA Alert (02/2017): EA alert and FAQs on Review of Certificate of Employment Intermediaries course and test

Dear EA personnel,

- 1 The Ministry of Manpower (MOM) will be making major changes to the Certificate of Employment Intermediaries (CEI) course and test. As you may have new staff, please note the following information.
- The CEI was introduced in 2011 to ensure that all EA personnel understand and discharge their obligations under the law and are able to advise individuals seeking employment and employers on their rights and responsibilities. While attendance of the CEI course is optional, EA personnel and EA Key Appointment Holders must pass the CEI test. MOM has progressively enhanced the CEI course since 2011 to better equip EA personnel with the requisite knowledge to perform their EA work.
- As part of our continuous effort to ensure that it remains relevant to the industry, MOM embarked on a review of the CEI course and test in the second half of 2016, and consulted the industry associations, the Association of Employment Agencies (Singapore) and the Singapore Accredited Employment Agencies Associations on the changes. We have taken into account the feedback on the course content, the test format, and the inclusion of learning objectives for the CEI course.

Key Changes

4 The new CEI programme introduces the following changes:
