### Phishing Scams

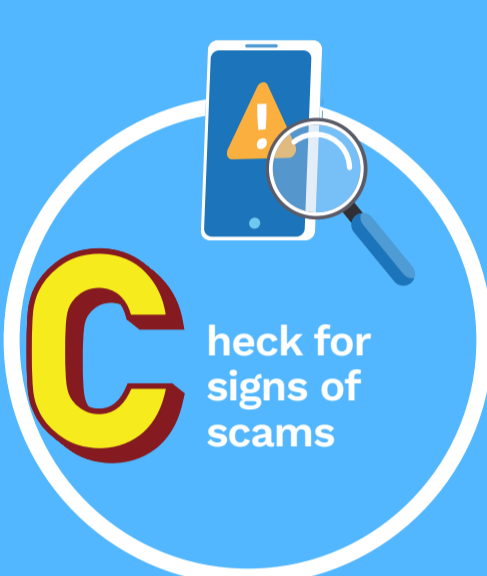
Scammers may trick her into revealing her banking details via suspicious links or asking for her personal information. She can protect herself by [watching this](#).

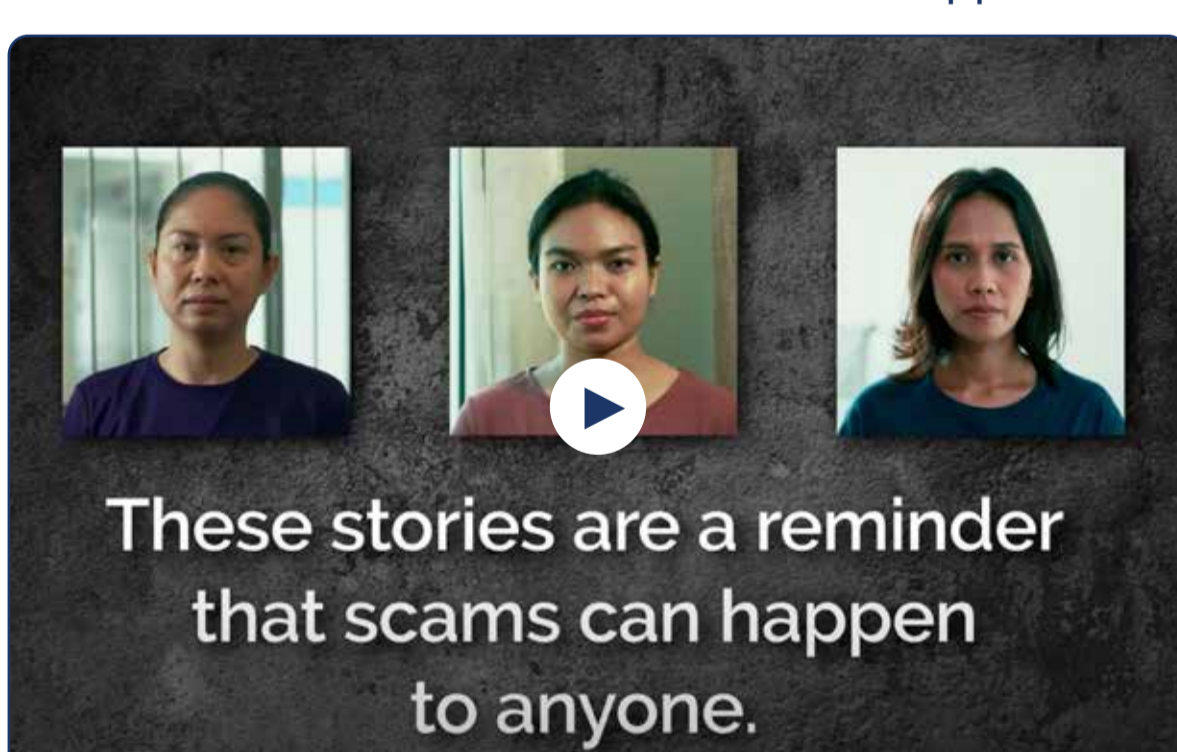

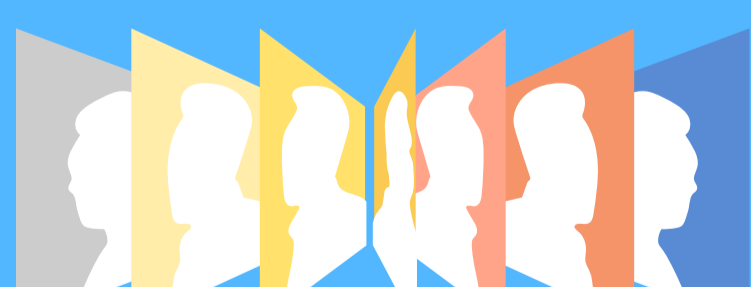
