Know your rights to compensation



What should I do with my medical bills and medical leave certificates for my work injury?

Keep a copy of your medical documents and give the originals to your employer as soon as possible. Your employer must pay you medical leave wages and medical expenses for your work injury.

When will I get paid?

Your employer will pay your medical leave wages by usual pay day. If you had paid for any medical treatment, he will also pay you back.

What if my employer wants to cancel my work permit? Will I still get my compensation?

Yes, you are entitled to your work injury compensation even if you no longer work for the company or your work permit was cancelled.

The Work Injury Compensation Act (WICA) protects employees injured at work. Under WICA, injured employees can claim three types of compensation benefits:

- Medical leave wages
- Medical expenses
- Lump sum compensation for permanent injuries or death
