

Bringing in migrant workers

From 1 May 2022, you will no longer need to apply for an entry approval for non-Malaysian male Work Permit holders holding an in-principle approval from the Construction, Marine shipyard, and Process sectors. Here are the updated steps to bring them to the Onboard centre.

1 Apply for a [Work Permit](#)



Once your application has been approved, your worker will receive an [in-principle approval](#) (IPA) letter

2 Book a slot at the Onboard centre



Book using the Onboard booking system at least 3 days prior to the workers' arrival.

Upon booking, you will receive a confirmation email. Please check your junk or spam folder if you did not receive it.

3 Complete all pre-departure procedures



Before arrival in Singapore, you must:

- Ensure your workers are [fully vaccinated](#)

If your worker is from Bangladesh, India or Myanmar, they need to complete the [Pre-Departure Preparatory Programme](#) (PDPP)

4 Bring your workers to the Onboard centre



Upon arrival, your workers should complete the residential onboarding programme for **up to 4 days**, consisting of:

- Vaccination verification
- Enhanced medical examination
- Settling-In Programme
- Vaccination, if required

5 Your workers are required to bring along:

- ✓ [IPA letter](#) – employee's copy, full set
- ✓ Onboard booking confirmation email for a slot at Onboard centre
- ✓ A working smartphone with a local SIM card
- ✓ [Documentary proof](#) of vaccination
