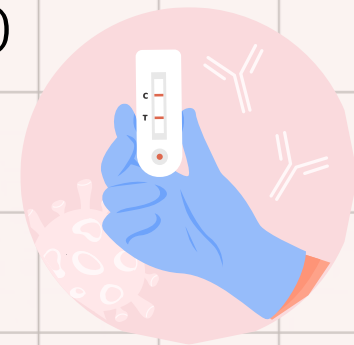
ACCESSCODE STATUS WILL TURN "RED"* FOR THE FOLLOWING GROUP OF WORKERS:



1

Workers who test** positive using the Antigen Rapid Test (ART) or Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test

- You should be isolated. Your AccessCode status will only turn "green" after you complete the COVID-19 recovery protocol***.



2

All unvaccinated or partially vaccinated workers. This includes workers who have recovered from COVID-19 beyond 180 days from their date of infection, but have not completed their vaccination requirements

- Your AccessCode will only turn "green" if you have completed your full vaccination regime and taken your booster shot when scheduled in order to maintain your fully vaccinated status.
- For workers residing in dorms, you may leave the dorm for essential activities or to visit the Recreation Centres (RCs). Please approach your dormitory operator to apply for RC visits.

*If your AccessCode status turn "red", you will not be allowed to go to work or leave the dorm.

**Workers with no symptoms and who have recently recovered should not self-test within 90 days from recovery. However, if you have no symptoms and inadvertently test positive within 28 days of your recent infection episode, there is no need to be isolated and you can continue with your daily life, including work. You should see a doctor if you feel unwell.

***This applies to all workers, regardless of vaccination status.
