

ENABLING MIGRANT WORKERS IN DORMITORIES TO RETURN TO WORK SAFELY

Dormitory operators, employers, and workers need to fulfil a set of requirements before workers can be allowed to exit dormitories for work.

EMPLOYERS



1. Show proof of approval by relevant government agencies to resume work
2. Confirm or update workers' addresses in Online Foreign Worker Address Service (OFWAS)

DORMITORY OPERATORS



1. Implement Safe Living checklist in the dormitory (e.g. tight entry and exit controls)
2. Provide MOM with up-to-date register of all residents

DORMITORY RESIDENTS



1. Report daily health status and update location and mobile numbers using FWMOMCare app
2. Download and activate latest version of TraceTogether. Scan here



DORMITORIES DECLARED CLEARED OF COVID-19 INFECTIONS AND ALL REQUIREMENTS MET?

IF YES

- Send list of workers approved to start work to dormitory operators
- Arrange dedicated transport and plan staggered pick-up and drop-off times of workers

IF YES

- Implement entry/exit controls to check that only approved workers leave dormitory for work
- Work with employers to plan staggered pick-up and drop-off times of workers from different companies

IF YES

- Leave dormitory only for work and return immediately after work

IF NO



Workers are not allowed to move in and out of the dormitories
