

## Getting on board the bizSAFE journey

“The threat of terrorism is real and closer than we think, and businesses must make preparations for a possible attack.” said Minister for Prime Minister’s Office, and Second Minister for Manpower and Home Affairs, Mrs Josephine Teo at the bizSAFE Convention 2018 on 7 Feb. bizSAFE is a risk management capability building programme to enable SMEs build a healthy workforce, and create safe and secure workplaces by strengthening the risk management capabilities of organizations.

With the rising terror threats in recent years, bizSAFE has been enhanced to include SGSecure elements to help organizations better prepare against terrorism. The newly enhanced bizSAFE programme is effective as of 26 September 2017.

Since the launch of the enhanced bizSAFE programme in September last year, about 2,100 companies have come on board the new enhanced bizSAFE programme.
