

## KEY SECURITY BOND CONDITIONS THAT WILL BE REMOVED

S/N	Security Bond conditions to be removed (with effect from 1 Jan 2010)	Clarification
1	That she shall not become pregnant or deliver any child in Singapore during the validity of her Work Permit/ Visit Pass/Special Pass unless she is already married to a Singapore citizen or permanent resident with the approval of the Controller of Work Passes. This condition shall apply even after the work permit of the foreign worker has expired or has been cancelled or revoked.	These remain as existing Work Permit conditions imposed on foreign workers. Employers who are aware that their foreign workers have breached these Work Permit conditions will be required to report them to MOM.
2	That he/she shall not get married to a Singapore citizen or a permanent resident during his/her stay in Singapore.	
3	That each of them shall comply with the provisions of the Immigration Act and any regulations made under the Immigration Act.	These conditions were previously under the Immigration Act and will now be introduced as new Work Permit conditions on foreign workers. Employers who are aware that their foreign workers have breached these Work Permit conditions will be required to report them to MOM.
4	That he/she shall not engage in any activity detrimental to the security and well-being of Singapore.	
5	That he/she shall, within 7 days of his/her arrival in Singapore, submit himself/herself to and pass a medical examination for contagious diseases and drug addiction and pregnancy in respect of females.	Foreign workers who do not go for their medical examinations will not be issued with a Work Permit.
6	That he/she shall submit himself/herself to and pass a medical examination once in every 6 months or at such shorter intervals as may be necessary in respect of contagious diseases, and pregnancy in respect of females.	Foreign workers who do not go for their 6-monthly medical examinations will have their Work Permits revoked.
