Annex B – ABOUT THE NEW TRAINING PROGRAMME

The WSH Council has developed a new WAH course for supervisors, in consultation with the National WAH Taskforce. The course will equip supervisors with capabilities to plan and implement an effective fall protection plan and to ensure work at height activities are safely carried out.

To support the running of the courses, MOM has accredited three new training providers. Capital Safety Asia Group Pte Ltd, Asretec Pte Ltd and QMT Industrial and Safety Pte Ltd have been designated the providers to carry out this new training of line supervisors.

The duration of the course is 2 days, comprising theory and practical components. Course fees are priced at an estimated \$500 by the accredited training providers¹.

WAH Capabilities & Training Elements

At the end of the course, the supervisor must be able to develop and implement an effective fall protection plan comprising the following key elements:

- Identify the various Workplace Safety & Health (WSH) legislations / codes of practice / approved codes of practice / Singapore standards applicable to WAH
- Conduct Risk Assessment and Control Measures and Safe Work Procedures on WAH
- o Identify, use and care for various fall protection system and equipment
- Conduct training, incident investigations and emergency preparedness.
