SINGAPORE INTER-AGENCY TIP TASKFORCE

The Singapore Inter-agency TIP Taskforce, co-chaired by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and MOM, coordinates anti-trafficking initiatives and policy alignments between Government agencies in Singapore. The Taskforce includes representatives from SPF, Immigrations & Checkpoints Authority (ICA), Ministry of Community Development, Youth & Sports (MCYS), Ministry of Health (MOH), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) and the Attorney-General's Chambers (AGC). The formation of the Taskforce underscores the seriousness with which the Government views trafficking and aims to improve efforts in tackling the abhorrent international crime.

To fight trafficking, Singapore adopts a holistic strategy (known as the "4 'P's") against trafficking. The 4 'P's are Prevention, Prosecution, Protection and Partnership. This strategy emphasises constructing safeguards against human trafficking, prosecuting perpetrators, protecting victims and cooperating with other governments and civil society to encourage reporting and information sharing.
