### **About Safety Time-out**

The Safety Time-out is a timely move for industry to take stock of the existing safety provisions and implement necessary measures to keep safety practices in check and uphold good WSH standards. WSH personnel will review site practices and risk assessments, including:

- Assessing whether current WSH systems and procedures are in place or require improvements
- Identifying possible systemic lapses in WSH system and processes
- Identifying possible factors that, if not properly managed, may be contributing factors to accidents
- Taking necessary measures to address the lapses identified
- Taking proactive measures to prevent accidents and losses

During the exercise, the following will also take place:

- a. Top management walk-about on site to engage site personnel and emphasise the importance of WSH; and
- b. Site-specific workers workshops to recap on basic site safety, and reflect on what WSH meant to them and how they could play a part in upholding good safety onsite.

Following the Safety Time-out, site personnel would be briefed on the findings and any improvements that would be implemented.
