
### **Objectives**

**Key Features**

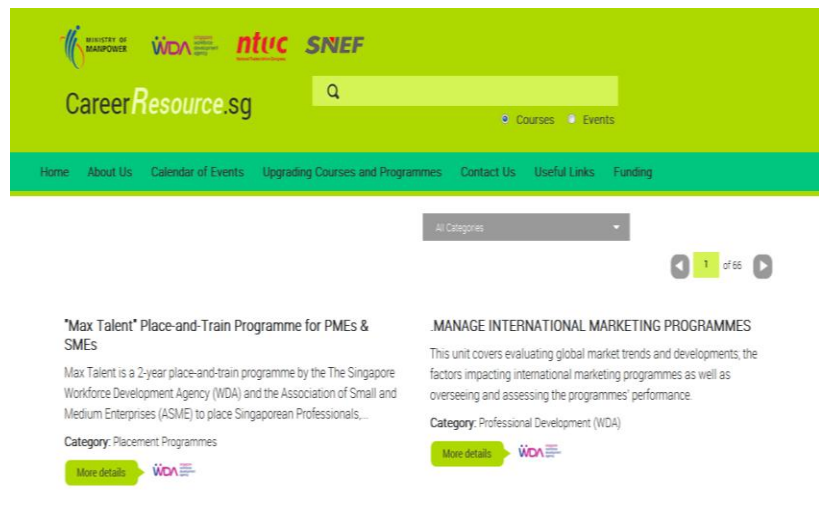
The portal is open for public access and no registration or log-in is required.

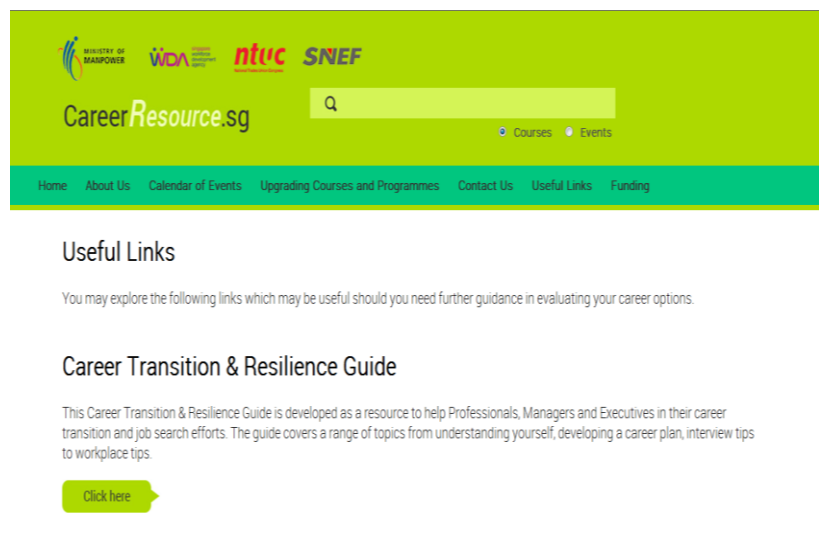
Upgrading Courses and Programmes
