LE Certificate Issued by Tan	Purported Examinations Conducted by Tan	MOM's Investigation Findings
1	Tan reportedly checked scissors lift 1 at a storage yard at 7 Chia Ping Road on 13 March 2016, and on 14 March 2016 certified it safe for use.	The scissors lift was not located at the storage yard at 7 Chia Ping Road where the purported tests and examinations took place on 13 March 2016 and 8 September 2016, as the scissors lift had been deployed at its lessee's store since November 2013.
2	Tan reportedly checked scissors lift 1 at the same storage yard at 7 Chia Ping Road on 8 September 2016 and certified it safe for use.	Visitor records also showed that Tan did not visit the lessee's workplace to conduct the test and examination while closed circuit television footages did not show Tan entering the store.
3	Tan reportedly checked scissors lifts 2 and 3 deployed at Marina Bay Sands on 12 September 2016 and certified both of them safe for use.	Both scissors lifts were deployed and kept within a restricted area in Marina Bay Sands, which Tan did not have access to.

5	Tan reportedly checked scissors lifts 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 at the construction worksite of Marina One on 30 September 2016 and certified all five of them safe for use.	Tan issued the five LE Certificates without performing any tests and examinations on the five scissors lifts.

10	Tan reportedly checked scissors lifts 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 at the same construction worksite of Marina One on 18 October 2016 and certified all six of them safe for use.	Tan issued the six LE Certificates without performing any tests and examinations on four scissors lifts. For the remaining two scissors lifts, Tan merely took photographs of them and did not conduct any functional tests to check if they were safe for use.
