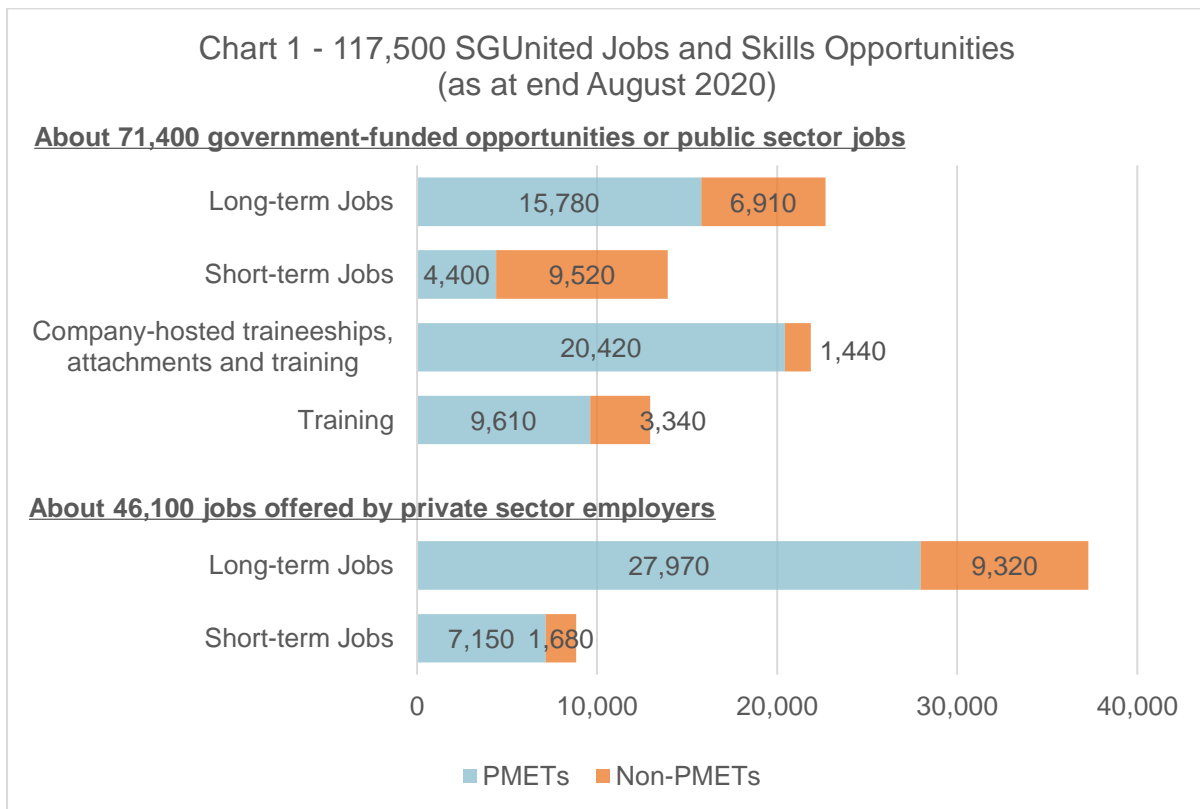

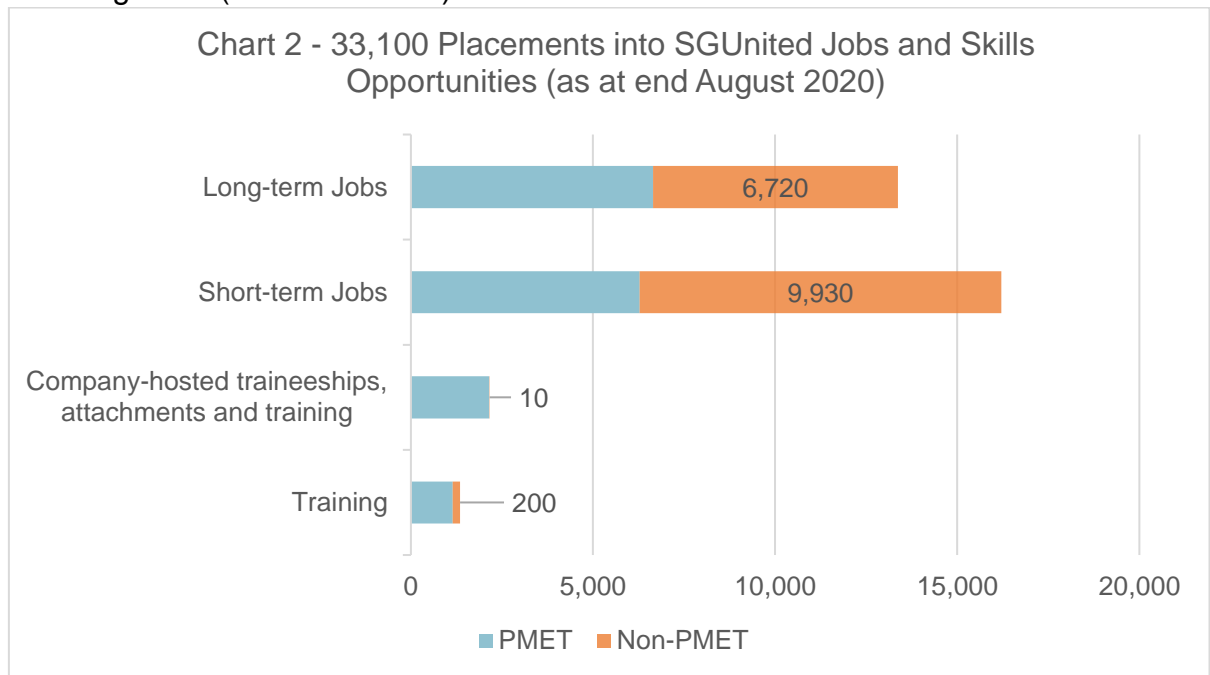
**The SGUnited Jobs and Skills Package at a Glance**

**Profiles who have benefitted from Workforce Singapore's programmes**

**Noraman bin Ibrahim, 51, Warehouse Executive, Storbest**

Noraman bin Ibrahim is a single father of two. He decided to leave his previous job as a Private Hire Vehicle driver in Dec 2019 in order to secure greater job security and more stable income. However, COVID-19 hindered his job search.

An outgoing individual, Noraman would make it a point to converse with his passengers whenever he could and this paid off. Through a referral from one of his passengers, he applied for a job opening with Storbest and successfully joined the cold chain logistics company as a Warehouse Executive through the PCP for Logistics Executive in Apr 2020.

While it was not his first stint in logistics – having left a tobacco logistics company in 2017 – Noraman had to reorient himself with the new work environment and learn how to handle cold chain operations and perishable food. These required him to possess new skills and knowledge, such as cold chain management, food hygiene, storage, etc.

**Marcus Yeo, 35, Supply Chain Manager, New Retail International**

Marcus is a former Pub Manager who had to search for better opportunities in May 2020 when his family-owned F&B business was hit hard by COVID-19. After two months of job search, he landed a job as a Supply Chain Manager with New Retail International in Jun 2020, where he manages the company's WeBuy e-Commerce platform.

The company enrolled Marcus in the PCP for Logistics Executive in Aug 2020 to support his transition from Food Services to Logistics. The programme equipped him with the necessary competencies and industry knowledge in e-Commerce platform, last mile distribution, and omni-channel logistics. As a result of his move, Marcus also saw his salary increase by close to 10%.

**Janessa Ong, 26, Operation Executive Trainee, ST Logistics**

Janessa Ong is a fresh graduate with a Bachelor of Business in Logistics & Supply Chain Management who is currently onboard the SGUnited Traineeships Programme as an operation executive trainee with ST Logistics.

In order to secure a stronger footing in the job market when the economy improves, Janessa decided to go for a traineeship to gain hands-on experience and be exposed to the real-world work environment. She sees a lot of growth potential in logistics, especially with the rise of Industry 4.0, and has a keen interest in digitalisation and

technology. ST Logistics, with its pursuit and adoption of latest technologies to augment and improve its operations, was able to satisfy Janessa's interest in these areas.

As part of her traineeship, Janessa was placed on a rotational programme which allows her to experience different department's processes and work, including how an AI-powered system could make the supply chain more resilient. She also received advice and guidance from her seniors in the workplace, which helped shape her views on her own career pathway and hopes to continue progressing in logistics even after her traineeship completes.
