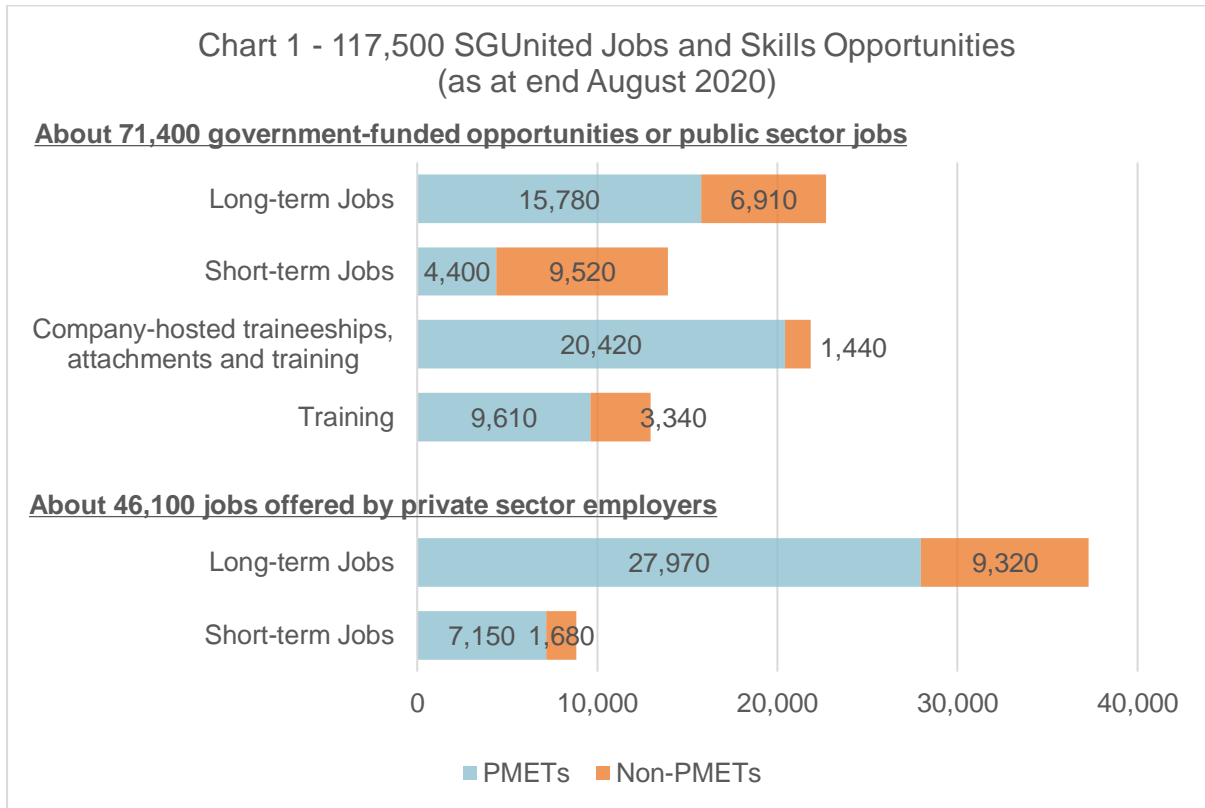

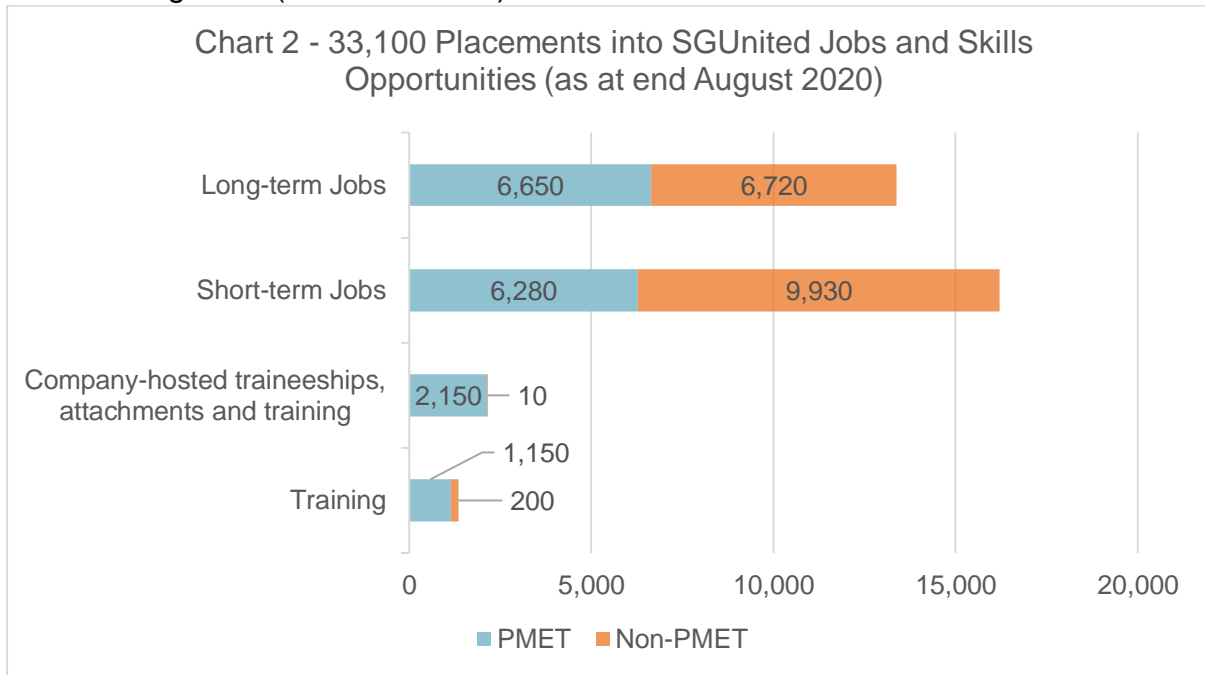

**Lam Lai Kheen, 61, Preschool teacher, Star Learners (Bishan Central)
PCP for Preschool Teacher**

It was not her first foray into the field of education; Lai Kheen had been a kindergarten teacher back in the 70s and 80s, teaching Chinese. She decided to join MOE in the early 90s as a secondary school teacher, continuing her love for the language and guiding the next generations. It was a 16-year-long career, touching and shaping the lives of many.

When she retired from MOE in 2017, Lai Kheen wanted to continue teaching. She took on private tuition but eventually found herself in want of a career that offers more stability. Although she has had experience in early childhood, the sector has changed a lot over the years. Lai Kheen was also apprehensive over potential stigma due to her age.

All these worries melted away when her new employer, Star Learners, placed her through the PCP for Preschool Teachers in July 2017 to reskill and equip her with a Professional Diploma in Early Childhood. The new insights she gained into the industry and the new competencies she picked up during her training helped ease her re-entry into the EC sector and allowed her to continue pursuing her passion for teaching. Now three years on, despite being 61 years young, Lai Kheen has set aspirations for herself to continue in the industry as an educator and spark in children the love and interest in the Chinese language. She is proud to be an EC professional, and finds immense happiness and satisfaction in her job.

**Veronica Sung, 30, Assistant Teacher, Safari House Pte Ltd
PCP for Preschool Teacher**

The banking and wealth management graduate had worked in various sectors from start-ups to facilities management to sustainability. When the COVID-19 pandemic hit, her former employer – a sustainable packaging company that mainly supplied the food services sector which was badly hit by the pandemic, saw a decline in sales. As her salary was based solely on commission from sales, Veronica decided to embark on a new career pathway that would provide better prospects and job stability. The former Business Development Manager hence started visiting the career fairs and came across an opening for assistant teacher. Veronica has always been interested in grooming the next generation and helping them to grow into useful members of society. Given the opportunity, she leaped at it, joining Safari House in Aug 2020.

To provide her with the formal training to embark on the career as an EC educator, Safari House enrolled Veronica into the PCP for Preschool Teachers. She looks forward to a fulfilling career shaping the lives of the future pillars of Singapore.
