PURCHASING THE PRIMARY CARE PLAN

From 1 April 2022, employers must purchase a Primary Care Plan (PCP) as part of work pass requirements for Work Permit and S Pass holders who live in dormitories¹, or who work in the Construction, Marine Shipyard and Process (CMP) sectors. Employers must declare that they have purchased the PCP for eligible migrant workers before work passes can be issued. Please note that false declaration is a serious offence.
