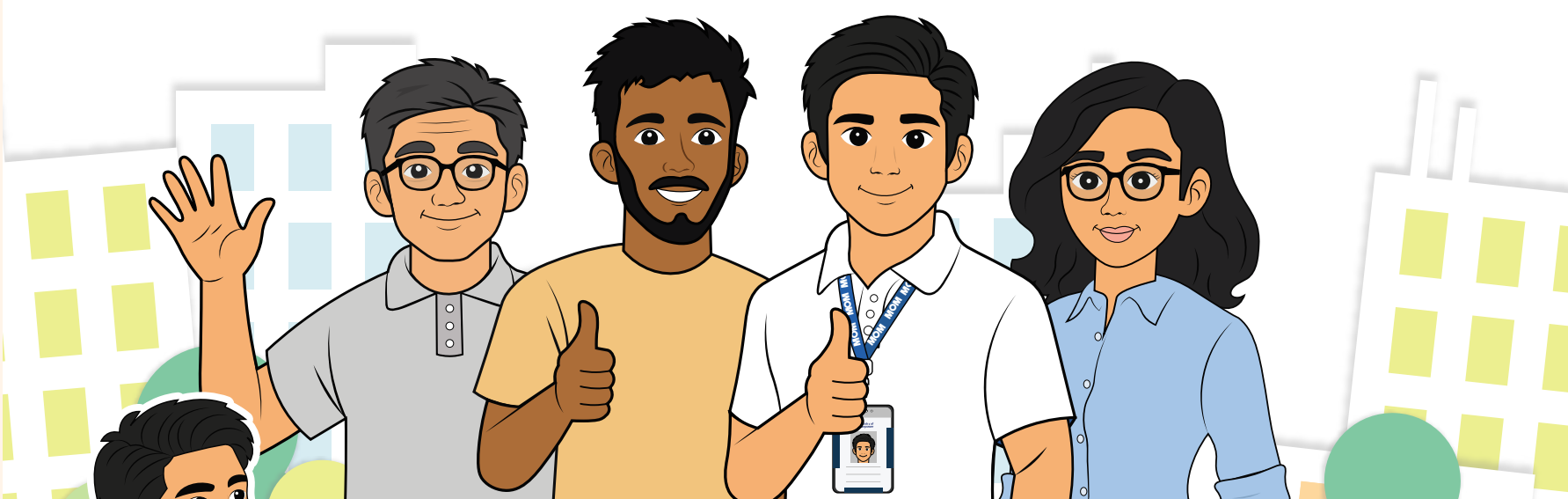


Migrant Worker Policy Updates: What Employers Need to Know


Introducing the first issue of MOM's newsletter to employers to keep you informed about important policy announcements, regulatory updates and resources for your migrant workers.



At MOM's Committee of Supply Debate 2026, we announced policy changes to help businesses transform, access talent, and stay competitive.

For Employers of Migrant Workers

(1) WE ARE INCREASING THE S PASS QUALIFYING SALARY:
From **1 January 2027**, the minimum qualifying salary for S Pass holders will increase from **\$3,300 to \$3,600**. This aims to enhance the quality of S Pass workers entering Singapore.



(2) WE WILL ADJUST WORK PERMIT LEVIES:
From **2028**, levies for basic-skilled Work Permit Holders in Marine Shipyard and Process sectors will increase by **\$100 and \$150 respectively**.



(3) WE ARE SIMPLIFYING THE LEVY STRUCTURE
Reduce the number of tiers for Work Permit Holders in Manufacturing and Services sector **from 2028**.



(4) WE WILL EXPAND THE NON-TRADITIONAL SOURCE OCCUPATION LIST
To include **8 new roles** across food services, social services and air transportation from **September 2026**.
