Launched in 2015, MOM's domestic helper online service is easy to use:

- ✓ You just need a SingPass (no special registration needed)

- ✓ Saves money (no Employment Agency fees)

When should I renew?

- Renew early to avoid a last-minute rush. The expiry date of the renewed Work Permit will be the full 2 years from the current one, so you do not lose out on the validity period when you renew early.
- When you receive the renewal letter or emails, usually about 5 weeks before the Work Permit expires, follow these 3 simple steps:

3 simple steps to renew your helper's Work Permit

1. Buy a new insurance package which includes a security bond, personal accident insurance and medical insurance. You can either buy it from your current insurer or a new insurer. Details of your current insurer can be found in the renewal letter.
2. Give your insurance company up to 3 working days to send the insurance details to MOM before you go online to renew the Work Permit.
3. Login to our online service at www.mom.gov.sg/FDW-eservices using your SingPass. Follow the easy steps on our system. You should complete the process in 3 minutes.

Note: Your helper does not need to have a valid passport at the time of renewal, but do make sure that her passport is valid if she is travelling out of Singapore.
