Encourage Your FDW to Activate TraceTogether

Dear Employer,

All residents in Singapore, including your foreign domestic worker (FDW), are encouraged to adopt TraceTogether (TT). This facilitates contact tracing, enables faster detection and mitigate the spread of COVID-19. With TT, your FDW will be notified and prompted to seek medical attention quickly if she is a close contact of an individual infected with COVID-19. With TT, it will help protect herself and your family. Here are two ways your FDW can activate TT.

Download the TT Mobile Application

Bluetooth must be turned on and the TT app should be kept running at all times.



Collect a portable TT Token

At:

Any Community Centre (CC)
open for distribution



Your FDW will need to bring her Work Permit card for verification and provide a contact number for registration.

You may also collect the token on her behalf (kindly note that you will need to bring her WP).

It is important to remain vigilant during this period. Remind your FDW about these safety tips whenever she goes out:

- Always wear a mask except when drinking or eating.
- Practise safe distancing by staying one metre apart.
- Keep gatherings to a maximum of five people.
- Avoid congregating at areas such as walkways and overhead bridges that can cause crowding and public obstruction.
- Avoid sharing food and utensils with others.
