

## SAY NO TO EXTREMISM

Dear FDW Employer,

All of us, including your foreign domestic worker (FDW), can play a part in keeping Singapore safe and secure given the rising terrorism threat to Singapore. There have been cases where FDWs have fallen prey to online extremist propaganda.

We would like to share the following information with you, and in turn, we hope you can share them with your FDW:

- i. Violent extremism is the belief and action of people who use, or support the use of, violence to achieve ideological, religious or political goals. This includes terrorism and other forms of politically motivated and communal violence
- ii. The Singapore Government does not condone any form of support for violent extremist activities, and firm action will be taken against anyone, regardless of nationality or religious background, who engages in such activities while working in Singapore.
- iii. If you or your FDW knows of anyone who may be radicalised, or may be involved in terrorism-related activities, alert the authorities immediately. Call the Police at 1800-255-0000 or the Internal Security Department at 1800-2626-473.
- iv. **Some indicators to look out for:**
  - Avid reading of radical materials
  - Spreading and reposting terrorism-related materials, pictures, videos and posts online or through other platforms
  - Stating intentions to commit terrorist violence or encouraging others to do so
  - Expressing support of or desire to join any terrorist groups, such as the Islamic State in Iraq and Syria (ISIS)
  - Providing material support, including raising or donating funds, to terrorist groups or others to carry out any act of violence
