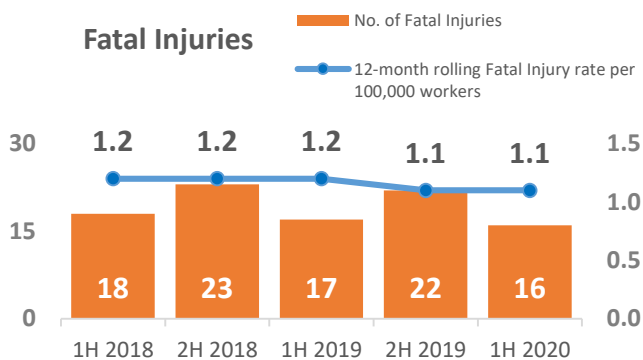


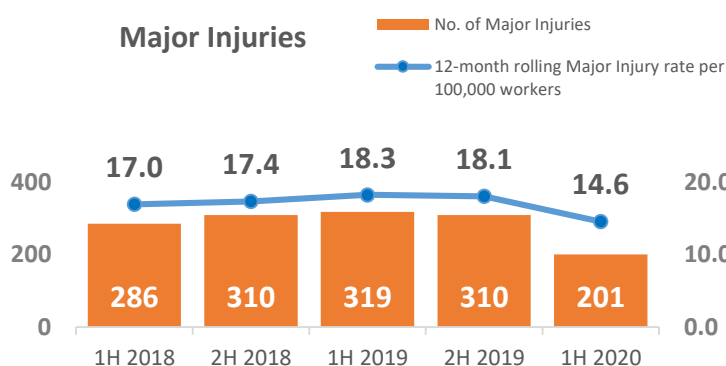
SINGAPORE WORKPLACE SAFETY & HEALTH REPORT

Injury rates and occupational disease incidence decreased in 1H 2020 compared to 1H and 2H 2019, likely due to reduced business activities

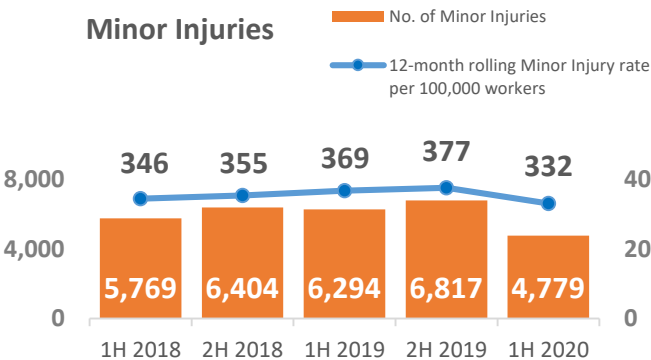
Fatal Injuries



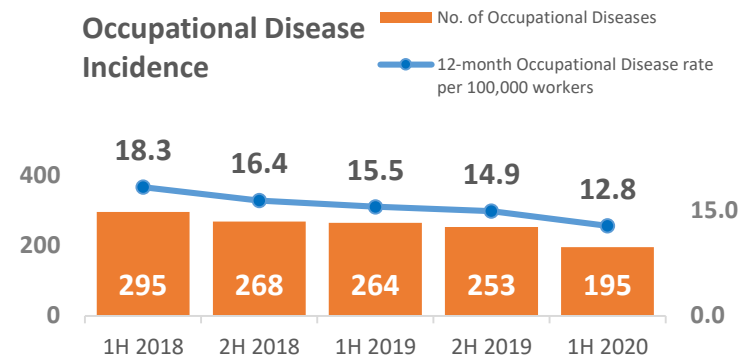
Major Injuries



Minor Injuries



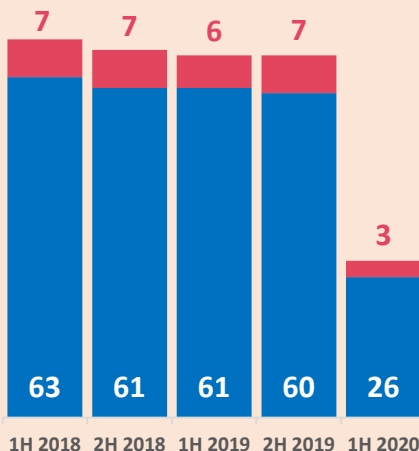
Occupational Disease Incidence



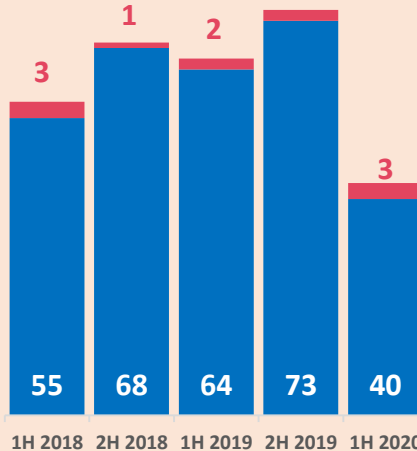

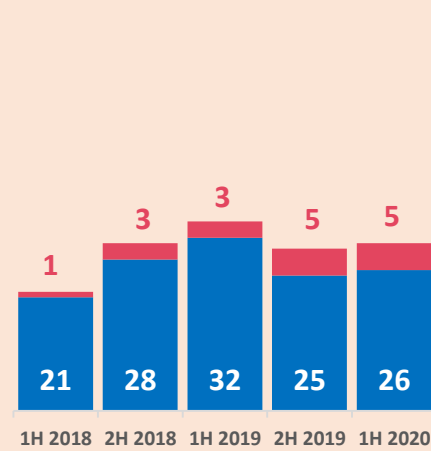

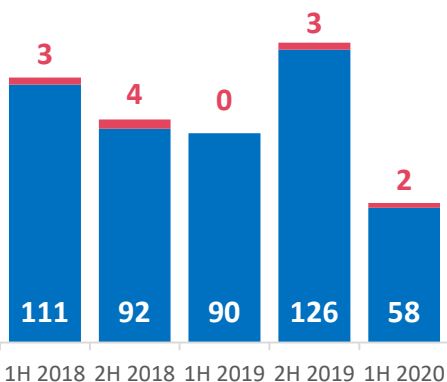

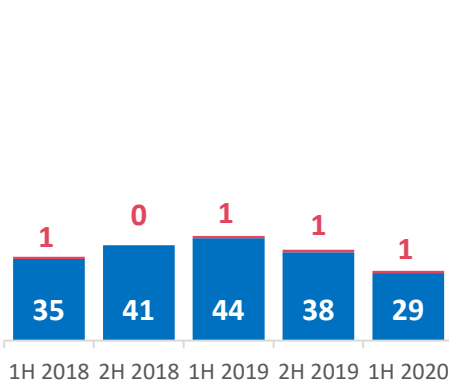
Falls from Height remained the top cause of fatal injuries in 1H 2020; Slips, Trips & Falls remained the top cause of workplace injuries

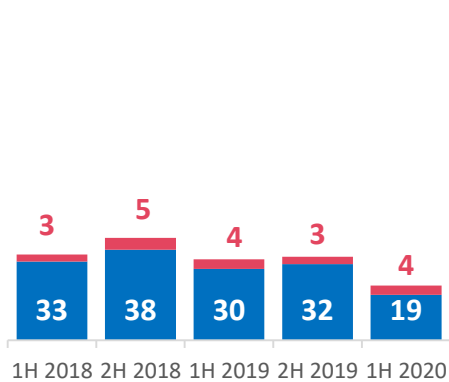

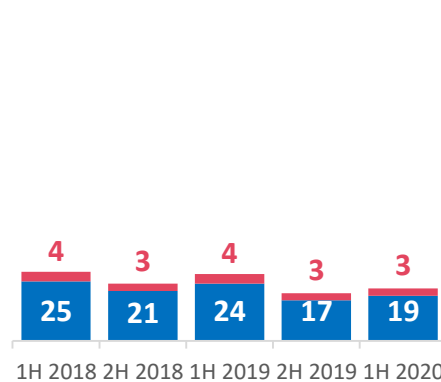
Machinery Incidents
