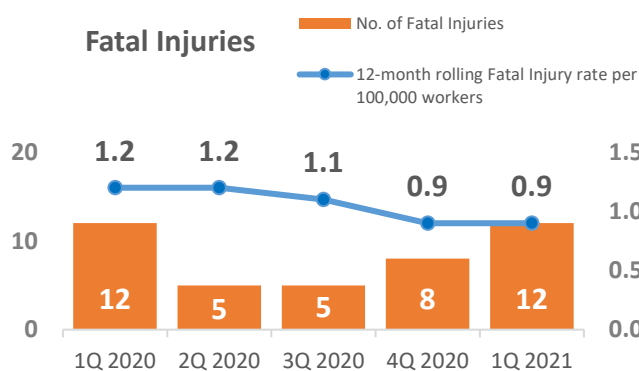


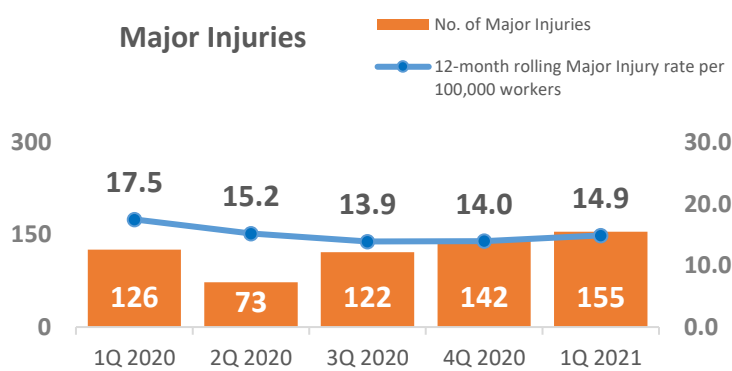
SINGAPORE WORKPLACE SAFETY & HEALTH REPORT

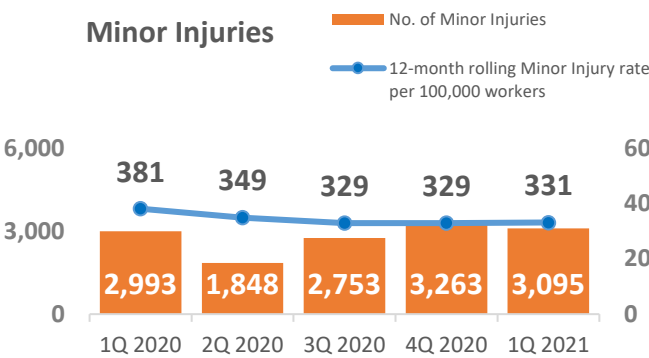
Fatal Injuries



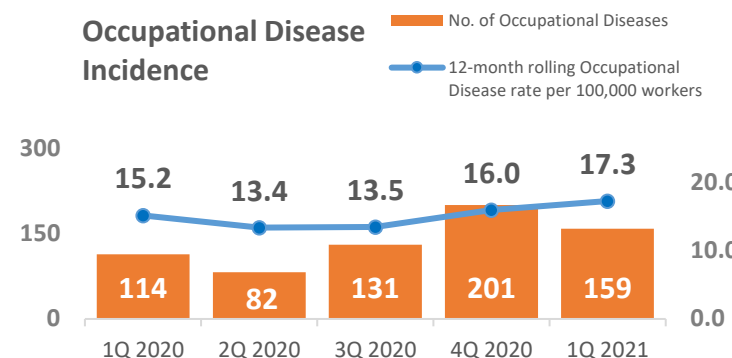
Major Injuries



Minor Injuries



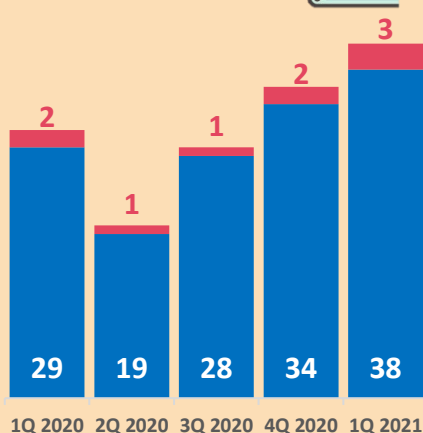
Occupational Disease Incidence



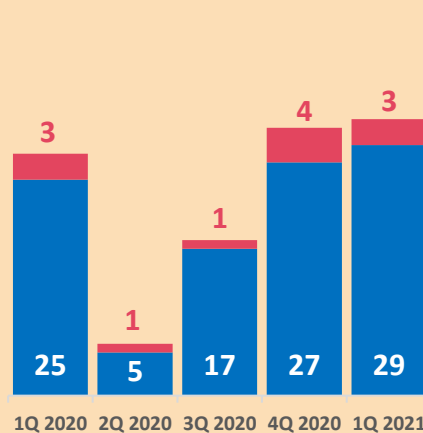
Manufacturing, Construction and Transportation & Storage remained the top 3 sectors/industries with the most fatal and major injuries in 1Q 2021.

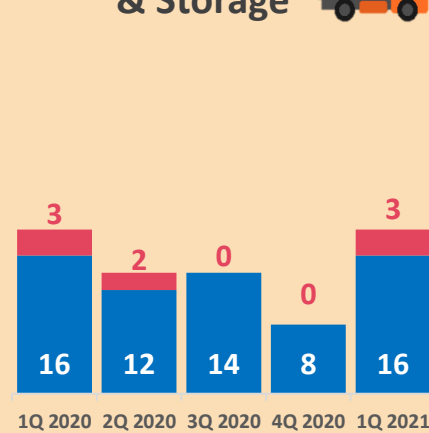

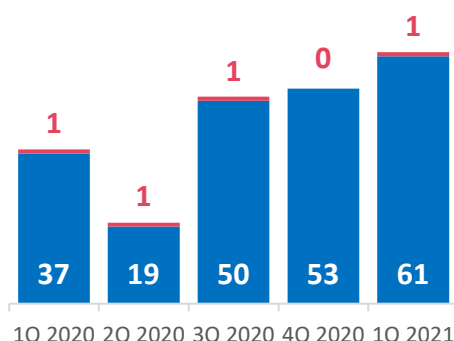

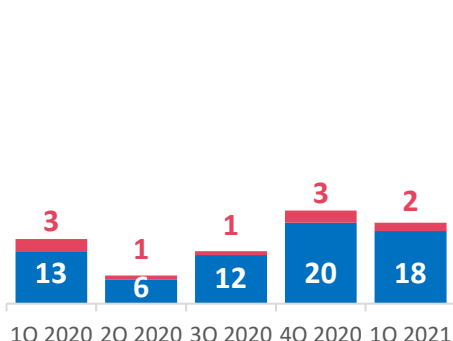
Slips, Trips & Falls remained the top cause of major injuries in 1Q 2020.

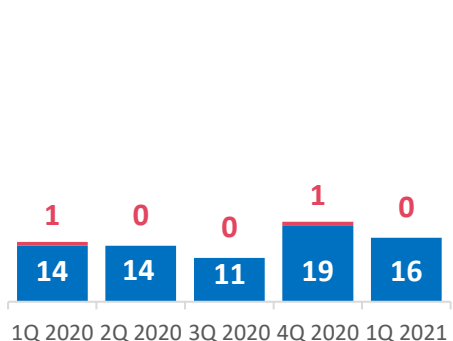
Slips, Trips & Falls



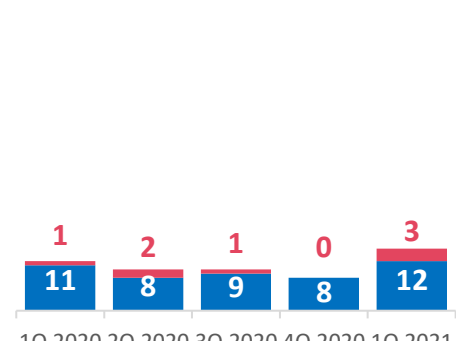
Falls from Height
