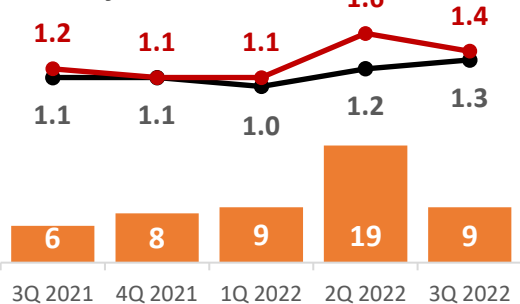


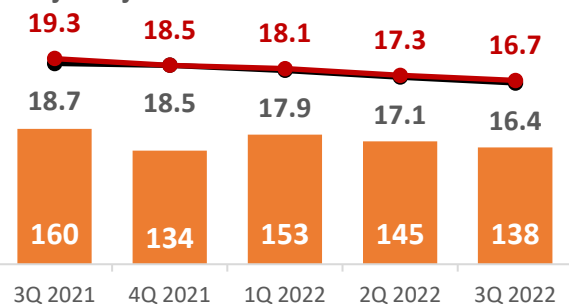
SINGAPORE WORKPLACE SAFETY & HEALTH REPORT

Fatal and major injuries in 3Q 2022 declined over the quarter.

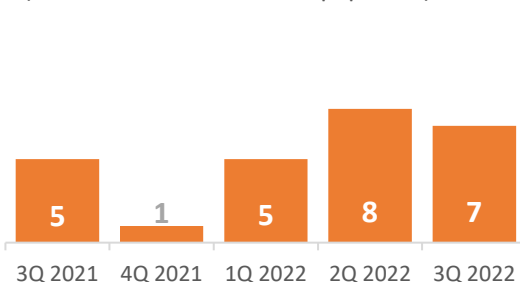
Fatal Injuries



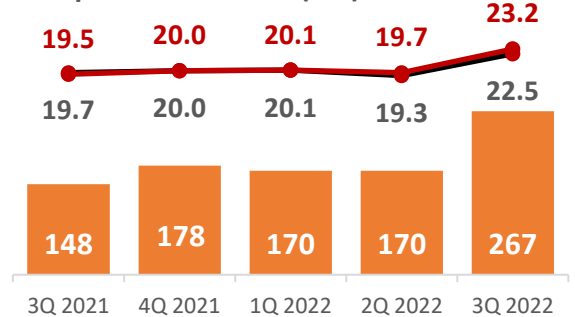
Major Injuries



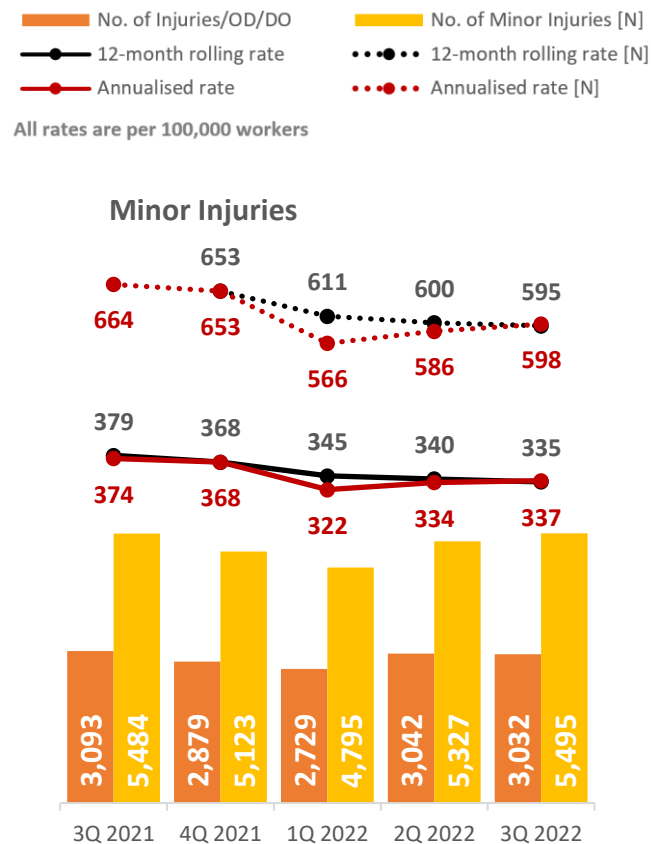
Dangerous Occurrences (DO) (Failure of structures or equipment)



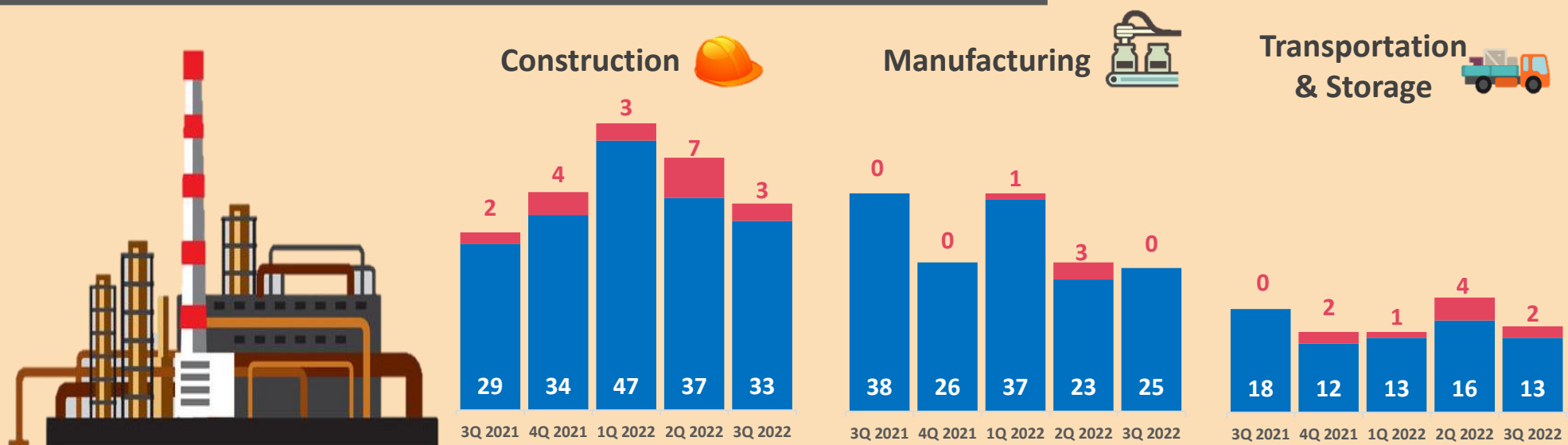
Occupational Disease (OD) Incidence



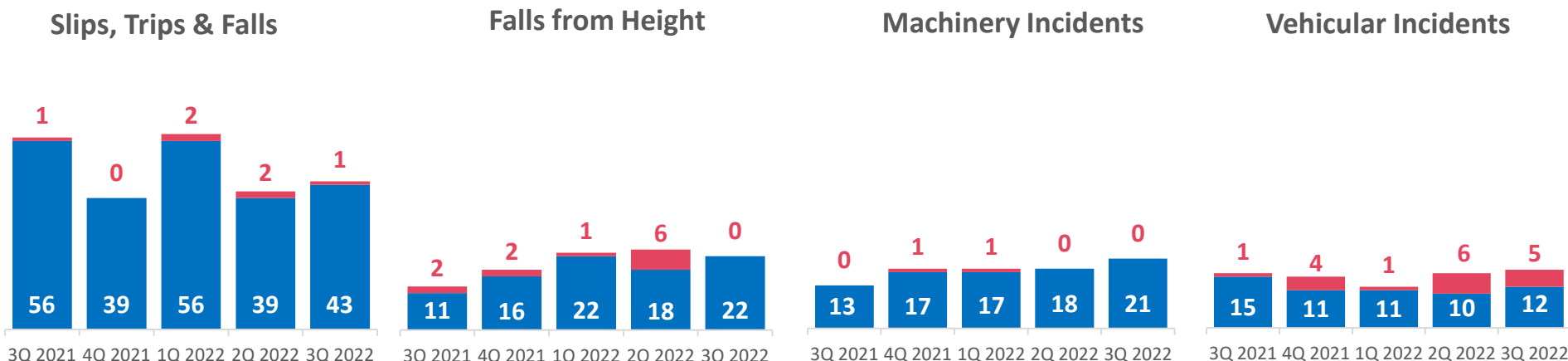
Minor Injuries



Construction, Manufacturing, and Transportation & Storage remained the top 3 sectors/industries with the most fatal and major injuries in 3Q 2022.



Slips, Trips & Falls remained the top cause of major injuries in 3Q 2022, while Vehicular Incidents remained the top cause of fatal injuries in 3Q 2022.

- [1] Annualised rate is an estimated rate should the current 6-month rate be sustained throughout the year.
- [2] 2022 figures are preliminary
- [3] Following the amendments to the Work Injury Compensation Act (WICA) which took effect from September 2020, employers need to report all work injuries with any instance of medical leave or light duties. From January 2021, injury numbers shared in WSH Report include injuries with at least one day of light duty or medical leave issued. Numbers presented under this new series will be marked with [N].
