## MAJOR INJURY

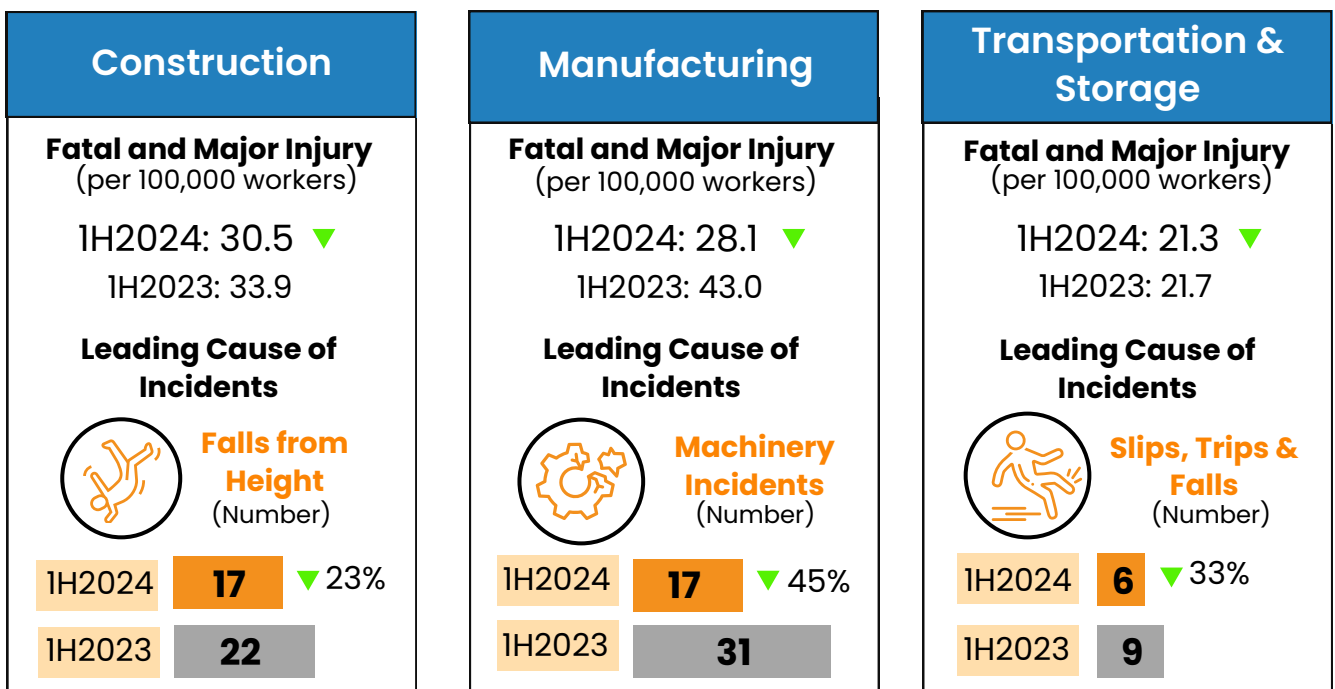
