



## Step-by-step Guide for SGWorkPass App

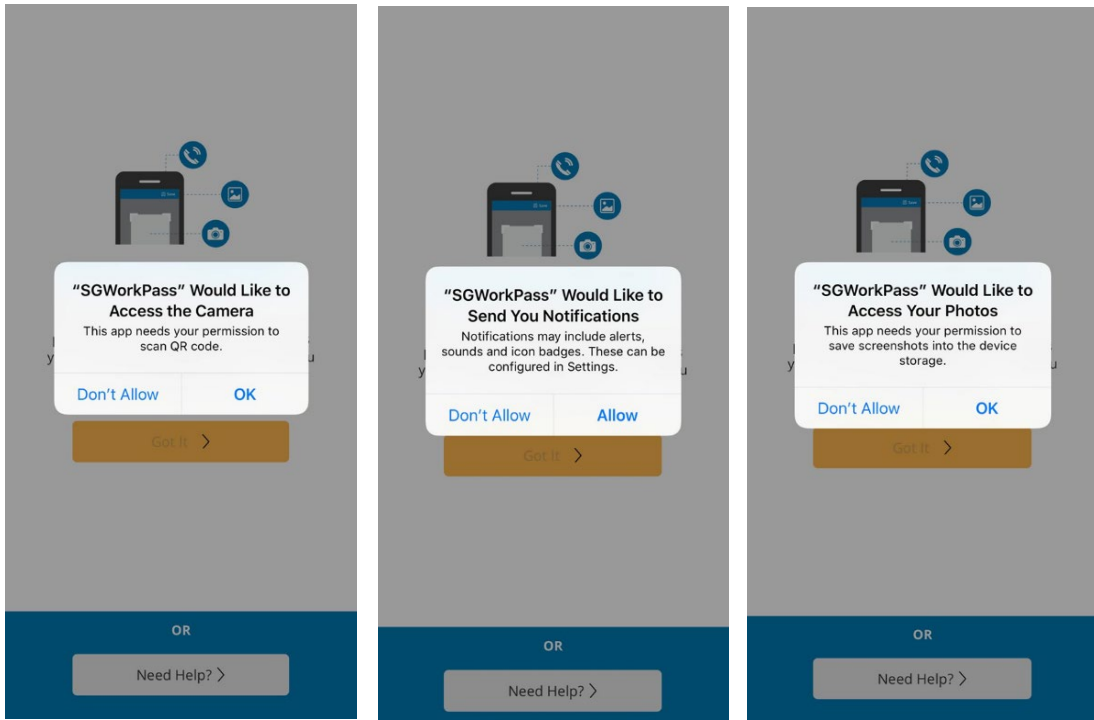
The SGWorkPass App allows you to check the work pass validity by scanning a QR code on the card. The App can be downloaded from Google Play Store or Apple App Store for free.

**Note:** From 2 June 2020, you can use the SGWorkPass to check if your foreign employees are permitted to leave their residences for work.

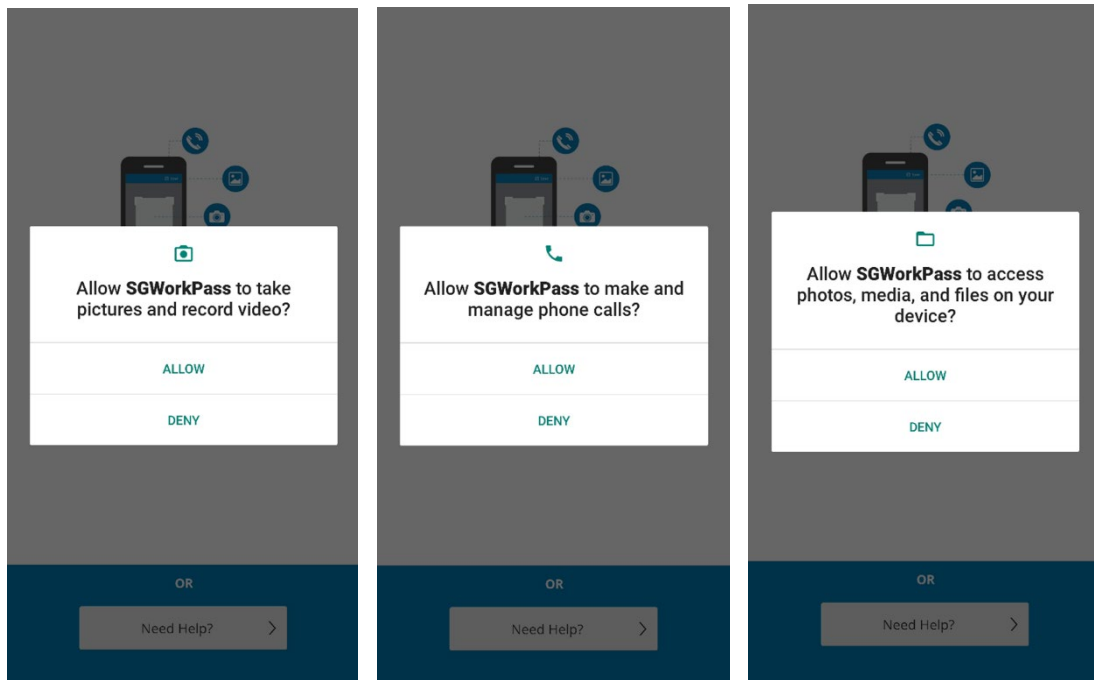
Step	Actions
1	<p>Search for <b>SGWorkPass</b> App from Google Play Store or Apple App Store and install it.</p>  The image shows the app icon for SG WorkPass. It is a blue square with rounded corners.
