## ANNEX A

### FACTSHEET ON LIFELONG LICENSING SCHEME

From 1 April 2012, Approved Scaffold Contractors (ASCs), Approved Crane Contractors (ACCs) and Authorised Examiners (AEs) will benefit from a new lifelong licensing scheme. This is part of the Ministry of Manpower's (MOM) move to be more pro-business, while maintaining strong oversight on their workplace safety and health (WSH) capabilities.

#### **Current Licensing Scheme**

2 Currently, the ASCs, ACCs and AEs are required to renew their licenses every two years. They have to submit renewal documents, along with the payment of a licensing fee ranging from \$150 to \$250.

#### Lifelong Licensing Scheme

- 3 In the lifelong scheme, these are the key requirements:
  - The current ASCs, ACCs and AEs will be automatically converted to the lifelong licensing scheme, upon the expiry of their current licences. They will no longer be required to send renewal applications and payment to MOM every two years. However, to ensure oversight on their WSH capabilities:

- a. ASCs and ACCs will be required to maintain a valid bizSAFE Level 3 or above certification that is renewable every three years<sup>5</sup>. This will include an audit by Approved Auditors for their Risk Assessment (RA) processes<sup>6</sup>.
- b. Similar to current process, AEs will be required to maintain a <u>valid</u> Professional Engineer Practising Certificate issued by the Professional Engineers Board Singapore.
- ii) To ensure the competency of the workers to perform work safely, existing training requirements will remain in place for ASCs and ACCs. However, with the revision of the lifelong licensing scheme, the training requirements are made clearer and listed out in detailed with specific courses to be fulfilled.
  - c. ASC Work at Height (WAH) training for supervisors (who possess at least two years' experience), as well as training requirements for scaffold erectors and supervisors.
  - d. ACC Approved Crane Erectors are required to attend training by manufacturers of the equipments used and/ or manufacturers for crane erection, alteration and dismantling. Approved Crane Erectors of Tower Crane ACCs are required to attend and pass the Approved Crane Erectors Course for Tower Crane for erection, alteration and dismantling.

5 ASCs, ACCs and AEs have been consulted on the requirements and will receive letter from MOM on the steps to take.
