Work pass holders may undergo up to three types of medical examinations (MEs) when working in Singapore.



Issuance MEs

are required for work pass holders (WPHs) to verify their fitness for employment before their work passes can be issued.



6-Monthly MEs (6ME)

are health screenings that certain WPHs need to undergo every six months whilst working here.



Renewal MEs

are to be completed by WPHs during the work pass renewal process.

ME Portal was launched in Dec 2021 for medical service providers (MSPs) to submit migrant domestic workers' (MDWs) 6ME results directly to MOM.

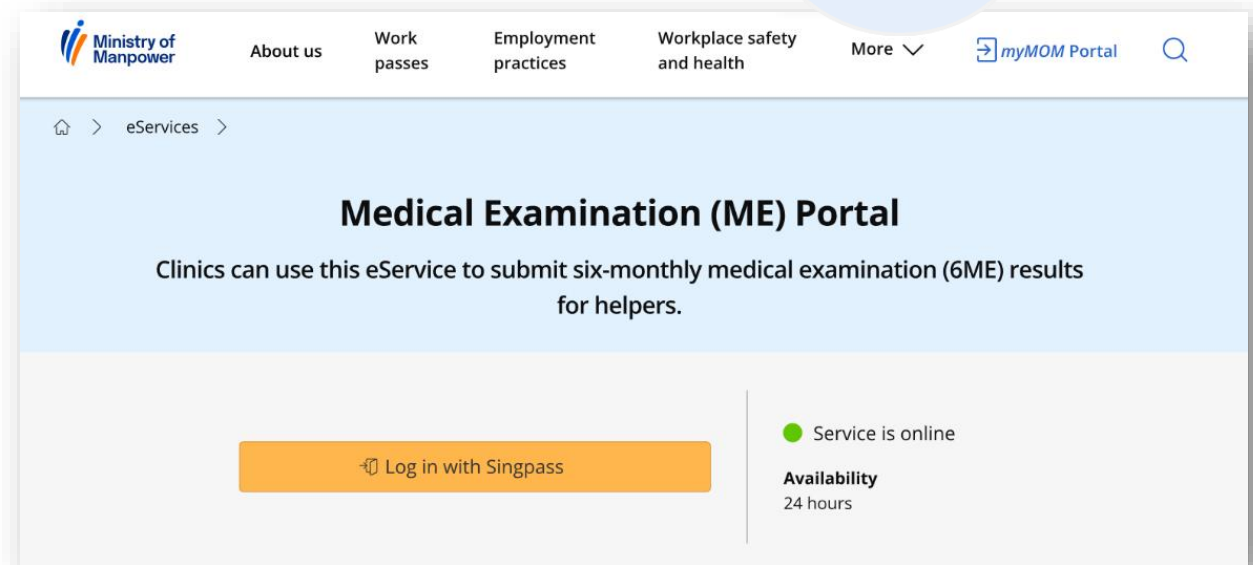
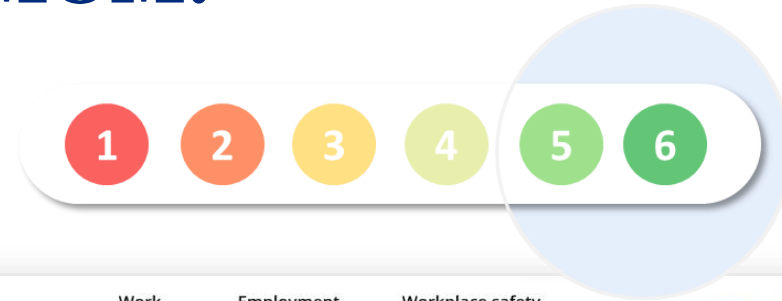

Before Launch

Clinic returns ME report to Employer

-  Clinic completes MW's hard copy issuance ME report, including:

 - National Tuberculosis Care Centre (NTBCC) referral outcomes at Clinic's discretion (if required)
 - Other specialist referral outcomes (if required)
 - Doctor's certification of MW's fitness for employment

After Launch


Clinic submits ME results via ME Portal

Employer completes issuance via eService

-  **From 27 Apr onwards**
Employer receives email notification after Clinic submits ME results to MOM

-  **From 4 May onwards**
Employer views MW's ME outcome and completes work permit issuance with new Issuance eService

For migrant workers who required referral to NTBCC, your clinic's ME submission on ME Portal should include their NTBCC referral results.



Conduct issuance ME

Clinic performs ME for worker, including chest x-ray



Complete NTBCC Referral flow

For chest x-ray with abnormalities, Clinic assesses if:

- a) NTBCC referral is needed,
 - i. Clinic refers worker to NTBCC
 - ii. Worker returns to Clinic with NTBCC clearance memo confirming completion of required treatment
 - iii. Clinic indicates "Abnormal, cleared by NTBCC" on hard copy ME form
- b) NTBCC referral is not needed,
 - i. Clinic indicates "Abnormal, no referral needed" on hard copy ME form with clinical assessment for the non-referral decision



Submit ME results on ME Portal




Clinic ensures NTBCC referral results are documented in MW's hard copy issuance ME report

We have scheduled for ME Portal to launch on 27 Apr and Issuance eService on 4 May, providing one-week transition for your clinic to adapt to ME Portal before employers start using the new Issuance eService.

After Issuance eService launch

- 3  Employer views MW's ME info and completes work permit issuance via Issuance eService **from 4 May (Mon)**

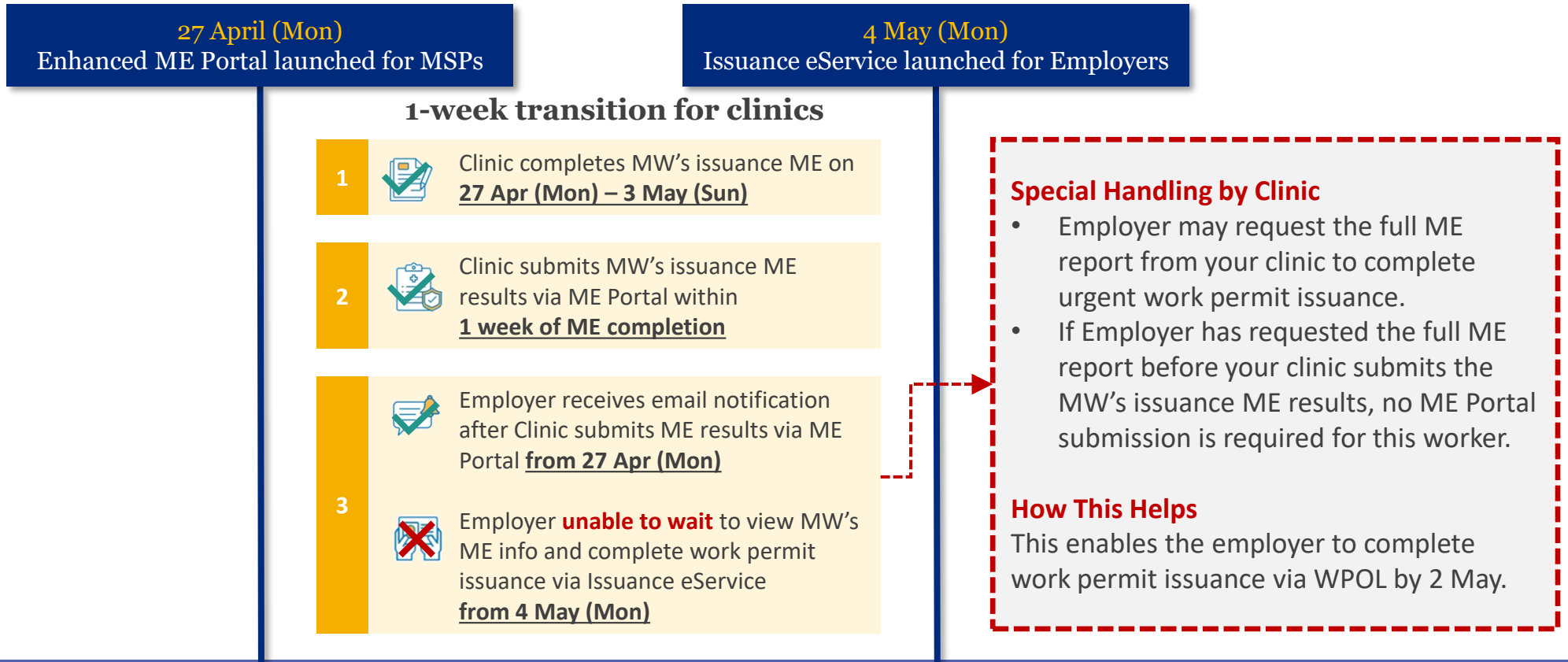

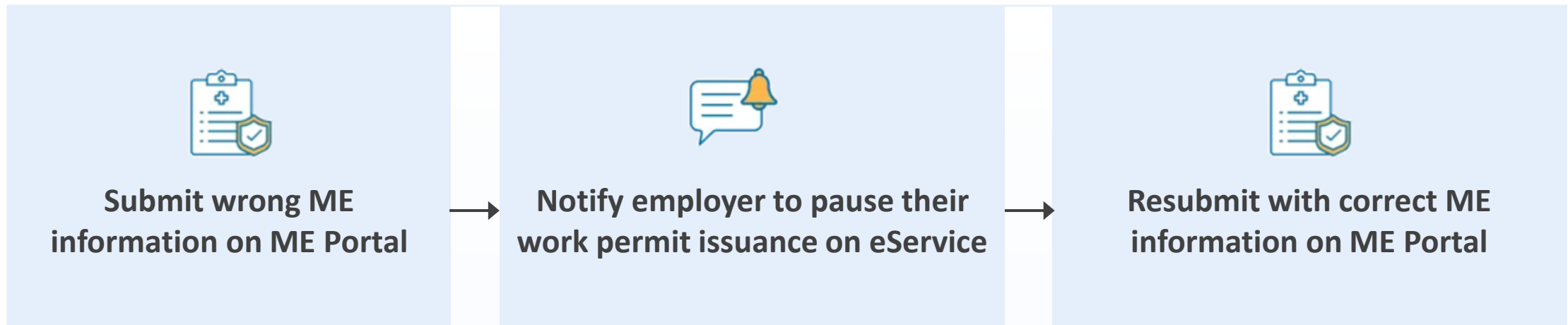
This enables the employer to complete work permit issuance via Issuance eService from 4 May.

Scenario 2

- Clinic completes MW's issuance ME on 27 Apr (Mon) – 3 May (Sun)
- Employer unable to wait to complete work permit issuance from 4 May



In the unlikely scenario that your clinic makes an error in the submission of the worker's ME, notify the employer to not proceed with their issuance process so that you can resubmit with the correct ME information.




