Launch of the Workplace Community Leader (WCL) Programme

The SGSecure Seminar 2018 saw the launch of the WCL programme, which seeks to support WCLs in preparing workplaces to respond to, and recover from a terror attack.



In his opening remarks at the seminar, then Minister of State for Manpower Sam Tan urged all WCLs to continually contextualise the SGSecure message and make it real for their respective industries.

At the seminar, MHA briefed WCLs on the latest terror landscape while MOM provided an update on the SGSecure@Workplaces programme. SATS Ltd also shared insights on how they integrated SGSecure 3Ps into their company's bizSAFE framework and processes. Seminar participants also received essential training on simple life-saving CPR and AED skills.

To support WCLs in their role, MOM will equip them with necessary capabilities via a three-pronged approach:

- **Enable** them to perform their role in advocacy and engagement
- **Involve** them in promoting SGSecure@Workplaces
- **Connect** them to the wider SGSecure network

Jurong Point GDx

Building owners play vital role in helping tenants prepare for terror threat



TENANTS ENGAGED!

- All Jurong Point tenants have appointed their SGSecure reps.
- These reps will receive regular information on how they can raise their workplaces' preparedness levels.
- Over 80% of tenants have signed up for bizSAFE.

Knives and a molotov cocktail were the chosen "weapons" used by two "terrorists" to cause chaos at one of Singapore's largest suburban malls.

Conducted on 19 April 2018, the ground deployment exercise (GDx) was part of the SGSecure@Workplaces efforts by Ministry of Manpower, Singapore Police Force and the Jurong Point Shopping Mall (JPSM) building management to sensitise and train JPSM's tenants on the SGSecure movement.

Recognising the importance of good coordination between building management and tenants in dealing with a crisis effectively, JPSM's security personnel engaged all 450 tenants individually to:

- Brief them on SGSecure advisories and resources available
- Encourage them to get on-board bizSAFE
- Encourage them to register their SGSecure reps
- Encourage them to download the SGSecure app

Prior to the GDx, JPSM took the opportunity to:

- Undergo a table-top exercise to identify gaps and areas for improvement
- Test their communication platform with the tenants
