

## Documents Required for Work Pass Applications

For non-English documents, you must upload the original document and an English translation. The translation can be done by a translation service provider.

Besides the supporting documents listed here, we may ask for other documents when we review your application. If you are asked for the verification proof of your candidate's qualifications, you can get it from [Dataflow](#) or other global verification agencies. Alternatively, if the verification agency or educational institute has an online instant verification portal, you can submit the screenshot and web page address showing the verification result.
